The PGO is the premier and largest nationwide geography competition for Junior and Senior High School students in the country. The event is a venue to showcase the students' skills and understanding in the field of geography through a series of friendly scholastic competitions.

The Olympiad will be composed of three rounds throughout the two-day event: the qualifying round, semifinal round, and final round. All these rounds will be held onsite in UP Diliman.
