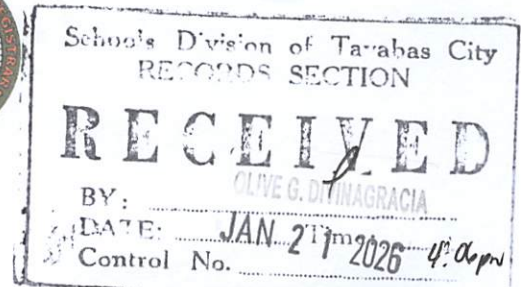

Originality: -The piece must be an original composition by the contestant.	10%
Overall Impact: -The student’s physical presence, voice and articulation.	10%
