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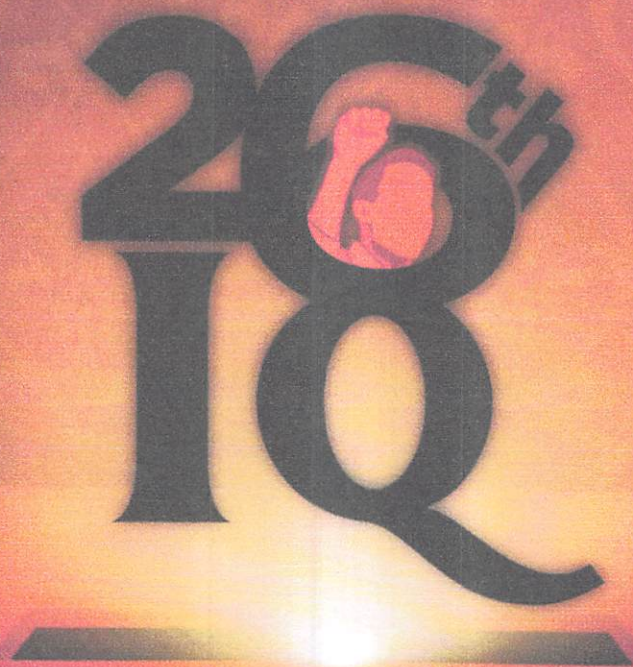

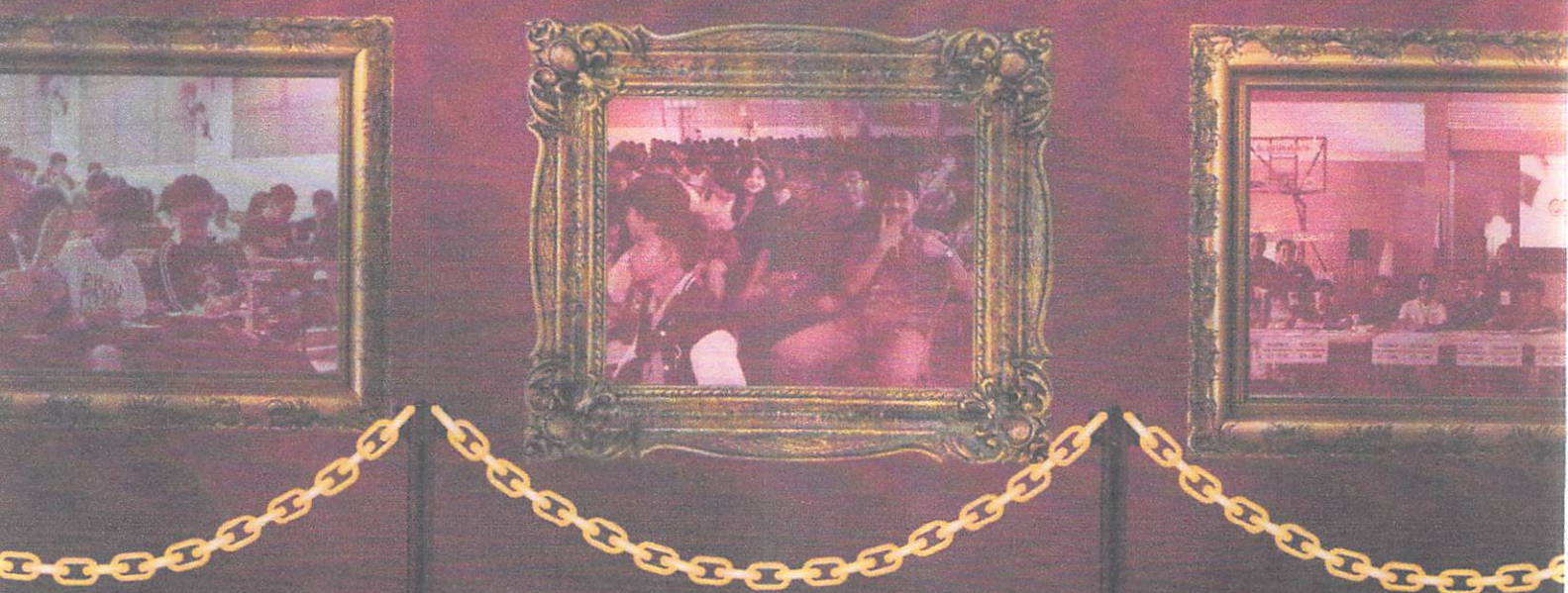
ACTIVITIES OF UP OROQUIETA

SPEED

SPEED is a bingo game and trivia quiz contest held in UPLB to serve as the organization's promotional activity inside the campus. This activity was headed by the Vice President for External Affairs of the Organization as it was conducted annually before the 2019 Covid pandemic.

COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAM REVIEW (CEER)

The College Entrance Exam Review (CEER) is one of the major activities of UP Oroquieta. This annual activity aims to provide help and assistance to all Senior High School Students (Grade 11 and 12) of Quezon Province who will take college entrance examinations, most especially the UPCAT.



INTELLECTUALS' QUIZ (IQ)

In line with the organization's objective to promote Quezon Province to UPLB and UPLB to Quezon Province, UP Oroquieta conducts an annual Intellectuals' Quiz Contest (IQ) open to all Junior High School and Senior High School students from different schools in Quezon Province. This activity features twelve sub-events as follows: (1) Quiz Contest that will cover Science, Mathematics, Social Studies, and General Information. Simultaneously, (2) Kultura Pakilala, (3) Sayawit, (4) Essay Writing Contest, (5) Pagsulat ng Sanaysay, (6) Poetry Making Contest, (7) Pagsulat ng Tula, (8) On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest, (9) Slogan-Making Contest, (10) Impromptu Speaking Contest, (11) Dagliang Talumpati, and (12) Photo Essay Contest will be conducted. The first and second placers in all sub-events will proceed to the PALAISIPAN to be held annually in UPLB.

PAMBANSANG LABANAN SA ISIP, SINING, AT PANITIKAN (PALAISIPAN)

Pambansang Labanan sa Isip, Sining at Panitikan (PALAISIPAN) is a national scholastic competition among high school students led by the Alliance of Varsitarian Organizations (AVO) in UPLB. PALAISIPAN started in 2013 and was spearheaded by the UP Isabela Society alongside UP Caballeros, UP Catandungan Los Banos, and UP Oroquieta. In its first edition, the team from UP Oroquieta dominated the said event and bagged the overall champions award. Last April 2024, the latest edition of PALAISIPAN was conducted and UP Oroquieta, represented by students from Quezon Province was once again hailed as overall champions.

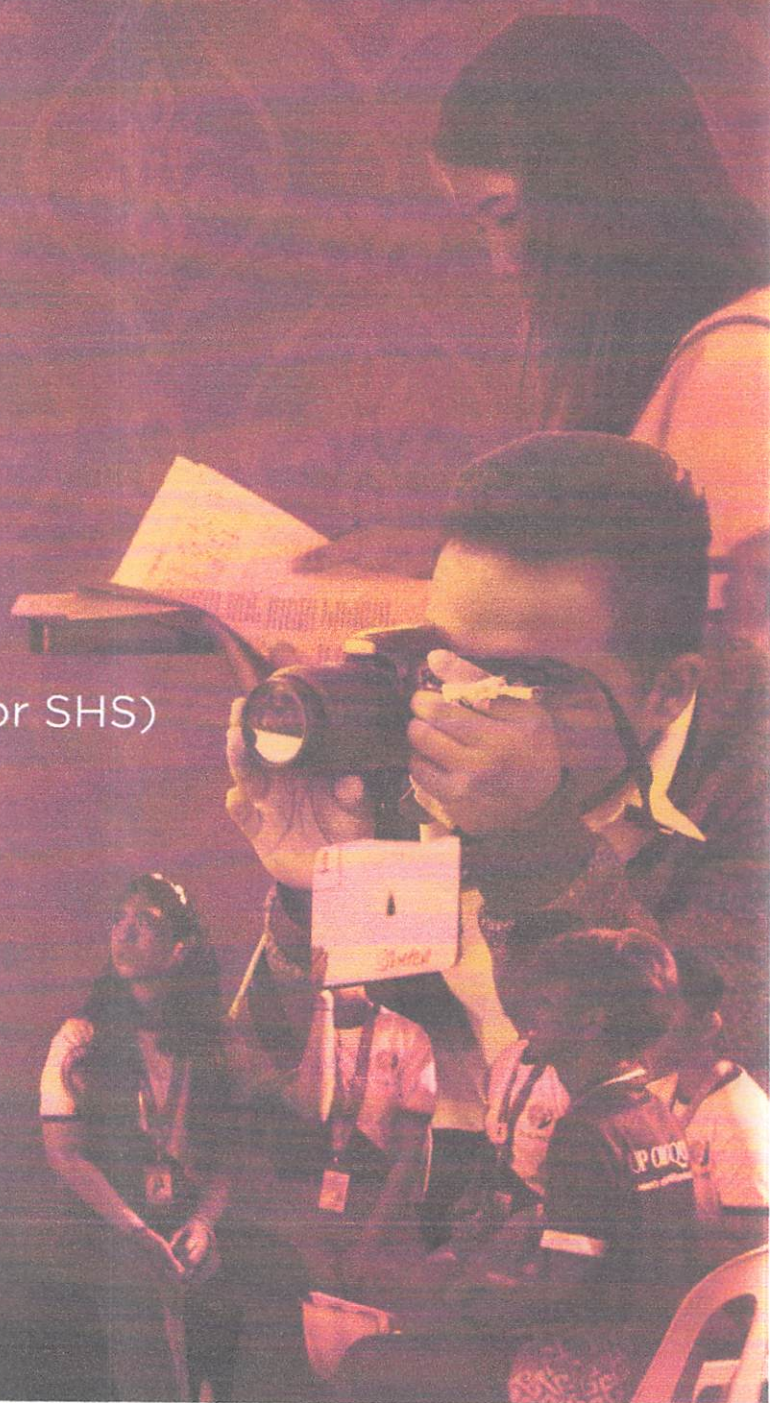

It currently consists of twelve (12) sub-events, each serving as an avenue for junior and senior high school students to showcase their talents, skills, and abilities.

OBJECTIVES

The 26th Intellectuals' Quiz (IQ) aims to:

1. Promote academic and holistic excellence among high school students in Quezon Province;
2. Foster and enhance camaraderie and sportsmanship among the participating schools in Quezon Province; and
3. Nurture the sense of patriotism of the youth today.

MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. The events are open to **all bonafide junior high school (JHS) and senior high school (SHS) students** currently enrolled in educational institutions from Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Quezon Province which are duly recognized by the Department of Education (DepEd).
2. The 25th IQ will feature **twelve (12) sub-events** with separate categories for JHS and SHS or as specified below.
 - a. Quiz Contest (JHS only)
 - b. Essay Writing (JHS and SHS)
 - c. Pagsulat ng Sanaysay (JHS and SHS)
 - d. Poster Making (JHS and SHS)
 - e. Slogan Making (JHS and SHS)
 - f. Impromptu Speaking (JHS and SHS)
 - g. Dagliang Talumpati (JHS and SHS)
 - h. Poetry Writing (JHS and SHS)
 - i. Pagsulat ng Tula (JHS and SHS)
 - j. Photo Essay (JHS and SHS)
 - k. Kultura Pakilala (JHS and/or SHS)
 - l. Sayawit (JHS and/or SHS)
3. The **lineup of representatives per school** may be composed of the following:
 - a. One (1) team consisting of four (4) members for the Quiz Contest
 - b. One (1) team consisting of five (5) to eight (8) members for the Kultura Pakilala
 - c. One (1) team consisting of ten (10) to twenty (20) members for Sayawit
 - d. One (1) representative for all individual competitions
4. Each representative is strictly limited to participate in one sub-event only.
5. The contest proper shall be held in two (2) parts — **morning contest proper** and **afternoon contest proper**. The **morning contest proper** will commence at **9:45 AM**, after the opening program, and will end at **12:00 noon**. The **afternoon contest proper** will start at **1:00 PM** and will end at **5:00 PM**. The following sub-events shall be conducted simultaneously during the respective contest proper:

6. All winners will be awarded during the **Awarding Ceremony and Closing Program**, which will start at **5:00 PM** and end at **6:00 PM**.

REGISTRATION

- Each school may **register** through a form accessible via **UP Oroquieta's Official Facebook Page** starting on **February 10, 2024 (Monday)**. Deadline of pre-registration is on **March 7, 2024 (Friday)**.
- A **registration fee** shall be collected either per individual or team, depending on the contest.

- Walk-ins are **NOT** allowed for the **Kultura Pakilala** and **Sayawit**.
- Walk-in schools** or those who submitted a registration form **later than the stated deadline** shall pay a **higher registration fee**. However, this is subject to change due to the limited number of slots available. Priority will be given to those who registered within the initial time period given.

5. **Payment details** can also be viewed on the said registration form.
6. All participants are expected to come to the venue at **6:45 AM** for the registration. Each participant must present an **official school ID** or any **valid ID** upon registration strictly for identification purposes.

SUBSTITUTION OF PARTICIPANTS

Change of contestant/s or substitution shall be **ALLOWED**, provided that they will submit all requirements and pertinent information (soft copy) for the new representative/s **at least three (3) days** before the competition proper. Requirements shall be emailed to **upo.externals@gmail.com** with the email subject: Substitution of Contestant_School Name.

CHANGE OF RULES

The UP Oroquieta reserves the **right to modify the rules** of the contests when deemed necessary upon consultation with the participants, judges, and arbitrators. Rest assured that everyone will be notified through email of any specific rule change.

ADHERENCE TO MECHANICS

All participants are required to strictly follow the established rules and guidelines set forth for the event. Failure to comply with these regulations will result in **disqualification**. UP Oroquieta reserves the right to disqualify any participant or team that violates or fails to adhere to the prescribed mechanics to ensure fairness and integrity in the competition.

QUIZ CONTEST

ELIMINATION ROUND

1. Participating schools are allowed to register and send only one (1) team, composed of four (4) members, in the Quiz Contest.
2. Each team must be well-rounded enough in **ALL** of the four (4) major categories: **Mathematics** (Algebra, Business Math, Geometry, Statistics and Calculus); **Science** (Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry and Physics); **Social Studies** (Philippine, Asian and World History, Economics, and Population Education); and **General Information** (Culture, Arts, Literature, Music, Sports, People, Places, Entertainment and Current Events).
3. The mechanics of the elimination round are designed to test the excellence of each participant. At the start of the quiz contest, the proctors of each team shall assign each team member a corresponding number (1, 2, 3, and 4). Once the numbers are placed on each member of the team, they are not allowed to exchange numbers with their teammates.
 - a. Before each question, a random number will be drawn, and the contestant assigned to that number shall be the representative who will answer the question.
 - b. A school will then be randomly picked, and a representative from the chosen school shall be the one to declare the category he/she wants for that specific question. This will take turns until all teams are called; thus, giving equal chances of choosing a category. This is called the **complete turn**.
 - c. Since there are a total of **forty (40) questions** for this round (levels are not in order), the number of complete turns will be based on the number of participating schools. If the remaining number of questions will not meet the complete turn, the quizmaster(s) will be the one to pick the category on each of the remaining questions until the end of the elimination round.
4. The questions for the elimination round shall be taken from the four (4) categories stated above. The elimination round will consist of **twenty (20) easy, twelve (12) average and eight (8) difficult questions**.

5. The questions shall be read by the Quiz Master(s), and the contestants must write their answers on the boards provided before the time is up.
6. The teams are allowed to answer once the Quiz Master(s) start(s) to read the question. However, the timer starts after the question has been read twice.
7. All questions must be answered in 10 seconds unless specified.
8. In writing the answers, kindly take note and observe the following:
 - a. All numerical answers must be expressed in accordance with the rule of significant figures unless stated otherwise.
 - b. Answers in word form must be in their correct spellings and proper capitalization. Proper names of people shall be written in full name (first and last names). Initials will not be accepted. The same follows for questions requiring dates and places.
 - c. If the answer being asked is a scientific name, it should be written in its proper form, underlined for both generic name and specific epithet.
9. The Quiz Master(s) will signal for the boards to be raised after the time limit has elapsed.
10. The answers shall be checked and verified by the proctors of each school, raising a colored flag to signal the Quiz Master(s). The flags to be used are the following:
 - a. Green for correct answer;
 - b. Red for wrong answer;
 - c. White for no answer; and
 - d. Yellow for concerns and protests.
11. A panel of judges shall be present during the competition.
 - a. The judges will address all the concerns, as well as protests raised by the participants.
 - b. Decisions made by the judges are considered as final and irrevocable.
 - c. Only the coaches and the contestants are allowed to file a protest. In doing so, they must provide sources from published materials or reputable websites (blogs and wikis shall not be considered). All protests must be raised before the next question is read; protests raised at a later time shall not be entertained.

12. Substitution of players who are not registered as the four (4) official delegates is generally not allowed. Should there be any replacements of delegates for the quiz contest due to unforeseen events e.g. sickness, death of relatives, among others, the staff and organizers must be informed immediately.
13. The five teams who earned the highest scores shall proceed to the final round of the competition.
14. There will be a sudden death match in case of a tie. The first team to score a point will proceed to the next round.

FINAL ROUND

1. The scores of the five teams from the elimination round will be reset.
2. The scores obtained in the Final Round shall be the sole basis in determining the winners of the Quiz Contest.
3. There will be a sudden death match in case of a tie. The first team to score a point will win the match.
4. More specific mechanics for the Final Round shall be given during the contest proper.

WINNERS

1. The team with the highest points at the end of the final round shall be named as this year's Quiz Contest Champion.
2. The Top 3 teams shall receive a trophy, certificates, and cash prizes. The Champion will receive three thousand pesos (PHP 3,000), the 1st Runner-Up will receive two thousand pesos (PHP 2,000) and the 2nd Runner-Up will receive one thousand pesos (PHP 1,000).

DISQUALIFICATION

Disqualification may be imposed upon teams due to, but is not limited to, the following:

1. Any misrepresentation in the registration documents;
2. Commission of behavioral violation, outright violation of rules and regulations of the event, or any act committed against the applicable laws; and
3. Any form of cheating.

ESSAY WRITING

MECHANICS

1. The topic for the essay writing contest will be given during the contest proper. The topic will be related to the general theme of the 26th IQ.

9. Each entry will be given an alphanumeric code to ensure impartiality and secrecy before its submission to the Board of Judges.
10. The decision of the Board of Judges is considered final and irrevocable.
11. The three (3) entries that will obtain the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, First Runner-up and Second Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will receive medals and certificates.
12. A Certificate of Participation will also be given to all participants.

PHOTO ESSAY

MECHANICS

1. The topic for the photo essay contest will be given during the contest proper. The topic will be related to the general theme of the 26th IQ.
2. Only the **first twenty (20) registrants** from the Junior High School (JHS) category and the **first twenty (20) registrants** from the Senior High School (SHS) category will be included in the official list of participants. Once the 20 slots per category are filled, no additional participants will be accepted.
3. A DSLR camera should be **provided by each participant**. A kit lens (18-55 mm) shall be used. The camera must be set to *manual settings*. Picture style and auto white balance are not allowed. In addition, the participant should prepare an empty memory card for their camera before taking pictures.
4. During registration, participants' cameras will be checked to ensure they meet the requirements for the photo essay contest.
 - a. To maintain fairness, **cameras will be temporarily surrendered** at the registration table to prevent any modifications.
 - b. For the safety of their equipment, **participants must bring a camera bag** labeled with their full name and school.
 - c. They will also be **required to sign a waiver** stating that the organizers will not be held responsible for any potential damage to their cameras. Rest assured, the organization will handle all cameras with care.
 - d. Cameras will be returned to participants before the photo essay contest begins.
5. Participants will be sent to a venue where they will be tasked to shoot pictures for one (1) hour only.
6. All participants are strictly limited to taking **only fifteen (15) shots** with their cameras. A participant who deletes a picture will be disqualified.
7. Participants shall only **choose seven (7)** out of their fifteen shots. Soft copies of the pictures must be submitted before printing.
8. Participants will be asked to lay out the pictures in a 10" by 15" white cartolina provided by UP Oroquieta.
9. Each participant should **provide a title** not exceeding ten words (either in English or Filipino), including articles. This should be written using a black or blue-inked marker provided by the participant.
10. Each entry will be given an alphanumeric code to ensure impartiality and secrecy before its submission to the Board of Judges.
11. The decision of the Board of Judges is considered final and irrevocable.
12. The three (3) entries that will obtain the highest percentage shall be declared as the Champion, First Runner-up and Second Runner-up respectively. The top three participants will receive medals and certificates.
13. A Certificate of Participation will also be given to all participants.

KULTURA PAKILALA

GENERAL MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

1. Each school is allowed to form **one (1) team** consisting of **five (5) to eight (8) junior and/or senior high school students** with flexible roles, including but not limited to directing, camera work, scriptwriting, production, and editing.
 - a. **Testimonial participants or extras** are **not** included in the official team count.
 - b. Only the participants are allowed to edit and produce the *documercial*, without any help from any outside parties. Violation of this rule will result in a **disqualification**.
2. Each team must produce a *documercial* that aligns with the **26th IQ theme**. It must incorporate cultural elements, including symbols, beliefs, values, and traditions related to leadership and governance. The video should also emphasize the following:
 - a. Youth contributions in advancing good governance
 - b. The evolution of leadership roles over time
 - c. The significance of active and informed participation in voting and governance

Note: A *Documercial* is a hybrid of a **documentary** and a **promotional video**, combining informative content such as **storytelling and interviews** with a clear, cohesive message. It aims to engage viewers through promotional elements, a call to action, and an emphasis on culture, traditions, and encouragement.

3. Participants should obtain proper consent from testimonial extras. They must ask if the extras are comfortable appearing on camera with their faces visible or prefer to have them blurred, along with the option to alter their voice tone for privacy.
4. The *documercial* must include a **credits scene** that properly acknowledges the **cast and crew, testimonial participants, extras, and all music used**.

TECHNICAL GUIDELINES

1. The video must **not exceed 5 minutes, including up to 30 seconds for credits**. A 5-point deduction will be given for every 30 seconds beyond the limit.
2. All video entries must be the team's original work. Using or uploading videos or photos from external sources, such as YouTube content created by others, is **strictly prohibited**. Only background music may be downloaded from the internet, provided that proper credits are given.
 - a. Ensure all audio and music used are **copyright-compliant**, and avoid using any content that could violate copyright laws.
 - b. Since all approved *documercials* will be posted on the official UP Oroquieta Facebook page, ensure that the video complies with Facebook's copyright infringement rules. Participants are encouraged to review Facebook's official

guidelines regarding copyright claims here:
<https://www.facebook.com/business/help/174681068731348>.

3. Acceptable formats: **MPEG, MP4, or MOV.**
4. Resolution: **1920 x 1080**; Maximum file size: **2GB**
5. Teams must also submit a **production portfolio** in a single PDF file containing:
 - a. Logline: A two-sentence summary of the video (50 words maximum).
 - b. Cast and Crew List, including extras.
 - c. Behind the Scenes documentation (photos of the production process)

SUBMISSION PROCESS

1. Each team must submit all necessary documents on or before **March 17, 2025** to upo.externals@gmail.com. The submitted files must follow the following format:
 - a. The email subject line shall follow the format: **<SchoolName> Entry for KULTURA PAKILALA - 26th IQ**
 - b. The overall google drive folder shall follow the format: **<SchoolName>_KULTURA_PAKILALA_26th_IQ**. It shall contain the following:

2. Only files uploaded within the given time frame will be accepted. Any files uploaded after the deadline will lead to disqualification.
3. UP Oroquieta may also decide to **outright reject and disqualify** any entry if it finds anything that is inappropriate or does not adhere to the established guidelines.

WINNER SELECTION PROCESS

1. Completed and checked entries will be shared for public viewing on the UP Oroquieta's official Facebook page on **March 19, 2025**.
 - a. Entries will also be displayed throughout the program of 26th IQ.

3. The performance must include both singing and dancing.
4. Performers have the freedom to **incorporate** instruments, music, acapella, and other creative elements into their act.
5. They may compose their own songs or modify the lyrics of existing ones, as long as they align with the event's overall theme.
6. Props and costumes are **permitted** but should complement the theme and not distract the overall presentation.
7. Dangerous stunts, such as lifting and tumbling, are strictly **prohibited**.
8. The performance should remain safe and within the bounds of acceptable stage practices to prevent injuries or risks.

ELIMINATION ROUND

1. Each team must submit a **four (4) to six (6) minute raw video-recorded performance** to upo.externals@gmail.com on or before **March 21, 2025**.
 - a. The email subject line shall follow the format: **<SchoolName> Entry for SAYAWIT - 26th IQ**
 - b. The **overall google drive folder** shall follow the format: **<SchoolName>_SAYAWIT_26th_IQ**. It shall contain the following:
 - i. **Sayawit performance: <SchoolName>_SAYAWIT_Performance**
 - c. Acceptable formats: **MPEG, MP4, or MOV**.
2. The board of judges shall assess the performances based on the criteria for judging.
3. Out of all performances, only the **top five (5) teams** will **proceed** to the final live performance.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINALISTS

1. The announcement of the selected top five (5) teams will be posted on our official Facebook Page (UP Oroquieta) on **March 25, 2025**.
2. Only the top five (5) teams posted are **eligible to perform live** on IQ 2025.

3. The top five (5) finalists must **submit** their official music or recorded instrumentals (if any) by **March 27, 2025**, via upo.externals@gmail.com . This will serve as their backing track for the live performance. Submission or resubmission beyond the date will **not** be considered.

LIVE PERFORMANCE

4. No substitutions of performers are allowed.
5. Participants are expected to display professionalism and discipline throughout the performance.
