MATHIRANG MATHIBAY 2025

The University of the Philippines Mathematics Majors' Circle (UPMMC) will hold the 33rd MATHirang MATHibay, an annual inter-high school mathematics competition, on March 15, 2025 at the University of the Philippines Diliman.

MATHirang MATHibay is designed to promote mathematics to high school students through a friendly competition. This competition consists of three rounds: Elimination, Oral, and Final Rounds. MATHirang MATHibay has been known for being heavily team-based, which stimulates teamwork for high school students. Moreover, it is a survival competition wherein teams have to climb to the top while avoiding possible elimination.

The competition is open to all high school learners (Grades 7 to 12) studying in the Philippines.

Every participating school may be represented by a maximum of two teams, each composed of three members. All participating teams will receive a certificate of recognition and winning teams shall be awarded with trophies, medals, and cash prizes.

Participation of public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2024 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2024-2025 and DO 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Timeon-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.

This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law), issued in DO 19, s. 2008, and reiterated in DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024.
