The entire essay excellently adheres to English or Filipino grammar. The spelling of the words is written correctly. Provided and followed proper citation guidelines for the source of information used.

The photos should reflect the theme of the event.

Capturing moments that showcase social sciences from the perspective of Filipino lives, and how it translates to social action for the alleviation of human sufferings.

Include a 150-200 word explanation of the photo and the original title of the photo taken. Filipino or English language can be used in writing the explanation. Only the use of mobile phones or smartphones is allowed. Failure to comply will be subjected to disqualification. Photos submitted must be original. Photos that are only downloaded online are prohibited.

TATAK SOKSAY: IMAHENGLIPUNAN





Cropping, adjusting brightness, contrast, and other image adjustments are permitted. Editing, such as removing something from the original image, will result in disqualification. It is highly encouraged to submit photos that has not been edited.

Only one entry per participant is allowed. If a participant submits two different photos, the committee will ask you to choose which one you want to submit.

The participant is responsible for obtaining permission from the individuals or property owners included in their photo. The UPLB Sociology Society will assume that all individuals or property owners included in the submitted photo have given their permission to be photographed.

The entry will be subjected to disqualification without any notice to the participants of unpleasant images depicting:

Sensitive images

- Threats to national security
- Potential threats to community peace
- Discrimination against women and youth.







CRITERIA

The image contains a relevant analysis of the social condition of the community which is aligned with the theme and conveys a clear message.

The image has the ability to capture the attention of the observers and audiences.

The caption follows the word count and significantly broadens the message of the image.

The photo adequately complies with all the technical and general rules of the contest. The photo is original, and only taken with a mobile phone.







Answer the question "How can the practice and perspectives of Social Sciences be used in exhibiting national consciousness in the Philippines?"

Original title and original text must be included.

The speech should be written in Filipino.

Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. All plagiarized entries will be removed from the list of entries. The UPLB Sociology Society has the right to revoke awards given to plagiarized works.

- Submissions of unedited video are encouraged. The video should only last The speech will be submitted in video format.
 - between two and five minutes. The video must be in landscape orientation.

Please put the entire speech into a word file and submit it with the video.

The topic, ideas, and message of the speech are relevant and appropriate to the theme. The points are also well presented, and the ideas are creatively plotted.

The speech was well delivered. Words are pronounced clearly. The tone is right and the actions are appropriate.

The speech was delivered on and within the given time. The grammar used is correct and meets the technical requirements of the contest.

- Each film output must be at least 3 minutes, but not more than 5 minutes in not allowed.
 - Use of royalty-free music allowed. However, participating teams are encouraged
 - to use original musical scoring.
 - Entries that contain copyrighted music are subject to disqualification. Entries that have been previously published, or commissioned by any third party
 - Any form of exposure to any commercial brand, identity, or personality is prohibited.
