Greetings from the Second Congressional Commission on Education (EDCOM II).

In support of the mandate of the Second Congressional Commission on Education (EDCOM II) to undertake a comprehensive national accessment and evaluation of the performance of the Philippine education sector, the University of the Philippines President Edgardo J. Angara (UPPEJA) Fellowship Award, a legacy of Senator Edgardo J. Angara, was revived last September 2023 to conduct research on education reform based on the priority areas identified by the Commission.

Among the UPPEJA research studies, focused on enabling transformation in basic education through systems, leadership, and culture, are titled "Understanding Systems, Creative Strategies, and Enabling Leadership" by Dr. Ma. Assunta C. For its methodology, the study will conduct a participatory action research workshop with the Department of Education Regional Directors, selected School Division Superintendents, and school principals.

In relation to this, Dr. Cuyegkeng and Dr. Alampay will conduct a workshop on "**Innovations in School Governance**" on April 16, 2024, from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM at the Blue Nest, 4/F Areté, Ateneo de Manila.

The workshop aims to:

a. Showcase Mental Health as an example of innovation in school governance; b. Share best practices in innovation in school governance among participating school leaders; and

c. Elicit policy recommendations on enabling innovations in school governance to support the goals of EDCOM II.
