The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) is an organization dedicated to advancing the rights and welfare of teachers through educational campaigns, policy advocacy, and social dialogues. In line with this mission, TDC will hold the National Seminar-Workshop on Education Policy Advocacy and Legal Protection for Teachers from May 1 to 3, 2025, at the Great Eastern Hotel, Quezon City.
