

SANAYSINING ARTS TRAINING FOR TEACHERS IN MAPEH, SPECIAL PROGRAM IN THE ARTS (SPA), SHS ARTS AND DESIGN COURSES AND RELATED ARTS SUBJECTS IN BASIC EDUCATION

1. In pursuit of the Region IV-A Subcommittee on Culture SCC Resolution No. IV-1-07-2024 “endorsing to the Department of Education IVA the Sanaysining Arts Training for Teachers and Dalubhasaan sa Tanghalan Masterclass, and requesting this agency to assist the ARTIST, Inc. to mobilize the participation of teachers”, Sanaysining will offer six courses on the following schedule:

2. Sanaysining aims to provide the teacher-participants with comprehensive training on the tools and techniques related to their field of arts specialization. At the end of each course, the teacher-participants are expected to:

- A. demonstrate an enhanced understanding of the elements, principles and properties of artistic expressions and locate art Philippine art productions within their specific cultural and historical contexts;
 - B. apply ethical and legal frameworks to artistic practice and education;
 - C. create and curate original art productions, utilizing diverse media and strategies, incorporating ICT tools;
 - D. develop culture-based lesson plans that promote a safe, inclusive and collaborative learning environment for art appreciation and creation and are aligned with current educational standards; and
 - E. critically evaluate and enhance their artistic practice and pedagogical approaches.
3. Sanaysining is open to teachers and subject area coordinators of MAPEH, Special Program in the Arts Grades 7-10, SHS Arts and Design Courses and other arts-related courses.

TRAINING FOR TEACHERS AND DALUBHASAAN SA TANGHALAN MASTERCLASS, AND
REQUESTING THIS AGENCY TO ASSIST THE ARTIST INC. TO MOBILIZE THE PARTICIPATION
OF TEACHERS”**

- WHEREAS,** the Sub-Committee on Culture (SCC) discusses and reviews existing policies and proposes amendments for the preservation and promotion of culture, conducts advocacy activities and initiates partnerships towards the promotion of cultural preservation and development, and provides technical assistance to local government units (LGUs) and other institutions on culture development;
- WHEREAS,** Department of Education (DepED) IV-A offers Special Programs for the Arts, Arts and Design Track, and Music and Arts Education and Health and Physical Education (MAPEH) at the Secondary level of Education;
- WHEREAS,** the teachers of schools offering arts courses must have continuous training in the different disciplines such as music, dance, visual arts, media arts, drama, and literary arts;
- WHEREAS,** the DepED IV-A is the identified agency with a mandate to enjoin the participation of teachers;
- WHEREAS,** private partner institutions can provide the necessary arts training to address the development of the artistic and pedagogical skills of the teachers;
- WHEREAS,** private partner institutions such as the Arts Research and Training Institute in Southern Tagalog Incorporated (ARTIST Inc.) can provide the necessary training for teachers in the arts;
- WHEREAS,** the DepED IV-A is requested to assist the ARTIST Inc. for enjoining the participation of the teachers;
- WHEREAS,** details of the two arts trainings are shown in Annex A, which forms part of this Resolution;
- NOW THEREFORE,** on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** to endorse to the Department of Education IV-A the SANAYSINING arts training for teachers and DALUBHASAAN SA TANGHALAN masterclass, and requesting this agency to assist the ARTIST Inc. to mobilize the participation of teachers;
