The Office of the City Mayor-Mobile Health and Medical Emergency Response Team will be conducting "Men's Health Awareness Day" on June 27, 2024 at Casa Comunidad de Tayabas, 1:00-5:00pm, with its theme ***"Kalusugan ni Tatay Ating Alagaan, Alamin mga Sakit na Dapat Iwasan"***.

To make this activity a more productive one, a collaboration with the Philippine Urological Association composed of doctors who specialize in male's diseases was organized. They will be facilitating lectures on Benign Prostatic Diseases and Erectile Dysfunction and performing Digital Rectal Examination to participants who will give their consent as screening procedure to detect prostate enlargement. There will also be mobile health services such as free medical consultation with laboratory and diagnostic procedures if deemed necessary to be performed by the MHMERT.
