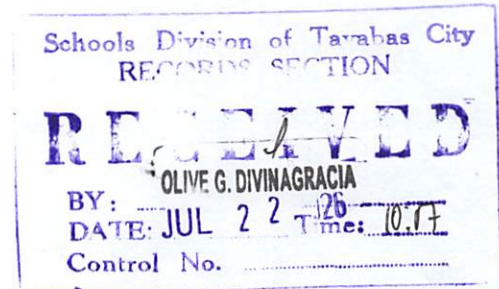

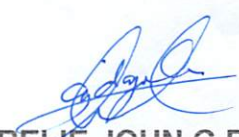


Good day, Sir!
