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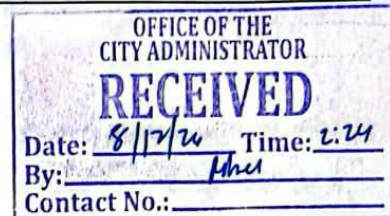

Dear Mayor Lim,

Respectfully, in response to the letter submitted by the Department of Education (DepEd) concerning the **2026 Quezon Council Kawan Holiday**, which is scheduled to be held on **August 15, 2026** at **Luis Palad Integrated High School (LPIHS)**, our office has prepared a **Proposed Traffic Management Plan** to address in the anticipated increase in vehicular and pedestrian traffic during the event.

During the meeting conducted yesterday with the concerned parties. The following traffic management measures were proposed:

1. Temporary One-Way Traffic Scheme

A temporary one-way traffic scheme from 6:00 A.M. – 8:00 A.M. is proposed along **P. Orias St. towards Gate 2 of Luis Palad Integrated High School (LPIHS)**, starting from the corner of **F. Perez St. towards the Ipilan Bypass Road**. Traffic will be allowed to move **one-way uphill**. This measure is proposed to facilitate the smooth flow of vehicles and minimize traffic congestion along the affected road.

2. Temporary Designated Parking Area

A temporary designated parking area is proposed along the **Ipilan Bypass Road** to accommodate the vehicles of participants, parents, guardians, and other authorized attendees. This will help prevent indiscriminate parking and maintain the continuous movement of traffic.

3. Strict Prohibition of Parking on Narrow Streets

Parking will be strictly prohibited along the narrow streets within the affected areas, particularly in **Brgy. San Isidro Zones I to 4, and Brgy. Ipilan**. This is necessary to keep the roads passable and accessible, particularly for emergency vehicles and residents.





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4. Anticipated Number of Participants and Vehicles

Based on the discussion during the meeting, approximately **3,000 students** are expected to participate in the activity. However, according to the information provided by DepEd, the total number of attendees may reach approximately **6,000 persons**, including parents/guardians. Considering the expected number of attendees, a significant volume of vehicles is anticipated in the area.

5. Assistance and Coordination with Other Agencies

For the effective implementation of the proposed traffic management measures, our office may be assisted by the **Philippine National Police (PNP), Force Multipliers, and concerned Barangay Officials through the deployment of Brgy. Tanods**. Their assistance will be valuable in traffic control, pedestrian management, monitoring of parking areas, and maintaining the implementation of the temporary one-way traffic scheme.

The proposed measures are intended to **ensure the safe, orderly, and efficient movement of vehicles and pedestrians** before, during, and after the activity, while minimizing traffic congestion and ensuring that affected roads remain accessible.

In view of the foregoing, we respectfully submit this **Proposed Traffic Management Plan** for your information, consideration, and approval.

We respectfully request your favorable consideration and support for the implementation of the proposed traffic management measures.
