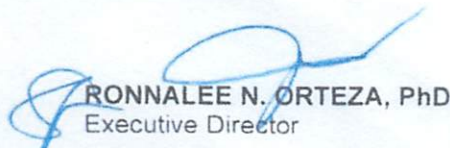
- Disseminating information of the PSHS National Competitive Examination through the Provincial Government's official communication channels;
