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SEAMEO SEN-CANVA CREATIVITY IN EDUCATION AWARD 2026

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Centre for Special Educational Needs (SEAMEO SEN), in collaboration with Canva, will host the SEAMEO SEN-Canva Creativity in Education Award 2026 with the theme, The Future of Creative Learning: Elevating Every Learner – Design for Change.

Recognizing outstanding educators across Southeast Asia who are transforming learning through inclusive, creative, and future-ready practices, the SEAMEO SEN-Canva Creativity in Education Award 2026 provides a platform for teachers to showcase classroom innovations and highlight how they foster student engagement, accessibility, and 21st-century skills in diverse learning environments.

The SEAMEO SEN-Canva Creativity in Education Award 2026 is open to all government and private school teachers from kindergarten, primary, and secondary schools with students aged 5 to 18 years old. Participation is limited to teachers from the 11 SEAMEO Member Countries: Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor-Leste, and Vietnam.

Participating teachers are invited to submit a classroom story by September 4, 2026, highlighting how they foster inspiring, creative, and future-ready learning experiences aligned with the prescribed theme.
