Greetings!

Sci&Tech Philippines respectfully invites your institution to **nominate exceptional students and educators for the 2026 Sci&Tech Philippines Awards**, a national recognition program that celebrates outstanding achievement, innovation, and contributions to science, technology, engineering, and innovation.

As a national network of Filipino professionals, scientists, engineers, innovators, and advocates, Sci&Tech Philippines seeks to recognize individuals whose excellence and dedication help shape the future of science and technology in the Philippines.

Presented in partnership with De La Salle Philippines, De La Salle University – Manila, the Benita & Catalino Yap Foundation, and Philippine Airlines, the Awards honor Filipino learners and educators who demonstrate academic excellence, research potential, leadership, integrity, and a strong commitment to using science and technology for nation-building. The program supports the national goal of strengthening science, technology, engineering, and innovation as essential drivers of inclusive growth, sustainability, resilience, and competitiveness.

We therefore invite your school to submit nominations under the following categories:

1. The Outstanding Sci&Tech Students (TOSS): For Senior High School graduates of school year 2025-2026 who demonstrated academic distinction (a General Weighted Average of at least 85%, with no grade below 80%), outstanding leadership, excellence in research and innovation such as a capstone project, and meaningful community engagement. TOSS is a competitive award; each school may endorse one (1) nominee only.

2. National Sci&Tech Honor Society (NSHS): For Senior High School graduates of school year 2025-2026 of exceptional academic excellence in STEM. Nominees must have a final General Weighted Average of at least 95%, with no grade below 90% in any STEM-related subject. Alternatively, they may qualify through the Alternative International STEM Achievement Pathway by holding a top award in a recognized international STEM competition. Unlike the other categories, NSHS is not competitive: all nominees who meet the criteria are conferred membership, and schools may therefore endorse as many qualified students as they have.

3. Sci&Tech Awards for Research Excellence (STARE): For Senior High School STEM teachers who demonstrate academic distinction, innovative teaching, excellence in research and mentoring, and meaningful community engagement. STARE is likewise a competitive award; each school may endorse one (1) nominee only.

All nominees must be Filipino citizens of good moral character with no record of disciplinary action or academic dishonesty, and must be officially endorsed by the School Principal, School





Director, or equivalent head of institution. Self-nominations and third-party nominations are not accepted. A student may be nominated for both TOSS and NSHS.

Completed nominations, together with all supporting documents, must be submitted by the corresponding email addresses below using the subject format:

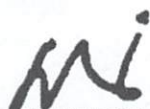
