
Regional Memorandum

DULARAWAN4: Dance-Musical-Drama Production

A Dance-Musical-Drama competition showcasing local cultural icons in their community. It is open to student-artists from public and private schools with a Special Program in the Arts (SPA).

All interested participants must comply with the following requirements:

- Each group may have a maximum of 8-10 members, including technical staff.
- The production must be original and should highlight local cultural icons from the community where the participating school is located.
- A minimum of two combined art disciplines must be presented.
- d. The entry must have a minimalist (symbolic representation) set, be an original work of the group, and be free from copyright issues.
- e. A basic or standard sound system will be provided by the proponent's technical staff.
- f. The performance must not exceed fifteen (15) minutes, including the intro and outro.
- g. Interested groups must register online at https://tinyurl.com/mr2dk6vr or scan the QR code on or before October 1, 2025.

The Performance competition will be held on **December 7, 2025** at SM North Edsa. PCEP will award prizes to the Top 3 best performers.

Winners will receive the following cash prize:

Grand Winner - Php 20,000.00 1st Runner-Up - Php 15,000.00 2nd Runner-Up - Php 10,000.00

- e. The performance must not exceed seven (7) minutes, including the intro and outro.
- f. The selected literary piece must be submitted on or before October 1, 2025, to avoid duplication of the poems to be performed.
- g. Submit entries through the link https:// tinyurl.com/dth2f86c or by scanning the OR code.

The Performance will be held on **December 6, 2025** at SM North EDSA. PCEP will award prizes to the Top 3 best performers.

Winners will receive the following cash prize:
