



PARAISONG PARISUHAT

Orlando Nadres' Paraisong Parisukat invites us inside a shoe store that looks like a "paradise" on the outside, but in reality, it feels more like a cage. Within its walls, workers give everything they have, time, effort, even their dreams, only to be repaid with low wages, empty promises, and false recognition. It is a world full of hope, yet heavy with frustration, where ambition often collides with the harshness of reality. The play is at once funny and heartbreaking. It makes us laugh at the foolishness of the painful truths behind those laughs. It shows us the irony of being praised for loyalty and hard work, while the deeper struggles of poverty, favoritism, and missed opportunities remain. And though written years ago, its message remains true because these struggles are still ours. In this staging, directed by Ivy Guadalupe Sumilang-Obdianela, brings new energy and vision to Nadres' masterpiece. With her bold direction and fresh approach to acting, every scene becomes alive with raw honesty, whether in moments of silence, bursts of laughter, or the sting of conflict. She reimagines Paraisong Parisukat not just as a play from the past, but as a living, breathing story that reflects our present. This is more than just a play. It is a mirror, a reminder, and an invitation: to laugh with the characters, to feel their struggles, and to look at the "square paradises" in our own lives, those places that promise comfort but often hold us back.





Orlando Nadres' Paraisong Parisukat takes the audience inside G. Mirasol and Sons Shoe Store, a so-called "paradise" that turns out to be nothing more than a square box of limitations, frustrations, and unfulfilled dreams. Within its walls, the lives of ordinary employees unfold—each struggling with poverty, lack of opportunity, and the false promises of hard work rewarded.

Characters:

- Don Gerardo Mirasol- The strict owner of G. Mirasol, obsessed with product quality but stingy with salaries. He represents the capitalist who profits at the expense of his workers.
- Pastora Dimagiba (Pastora/Uring) The old-maid store manager, proud and strict, believing the company owes its progress to her. She practices favoritism and mistreats subordinates.
- Isya (Simpilcia Cruz) A diligent, timid employee and gold medal awardee, content despite low pay. She is Al's love interest, symbolizing workers who endure in silence.
- Al (Alberto Reyes) Ambitious and sees G. Mirasol only as a stepping stone. Despite his dreams, he feels trapped by the company's meager salary and lack of opportunity.
- Emy (Emilia Dimansalan) Outspoken, foul-mouthed, and openly rebellious against Pastora. She embodies the workers' resentment against unfair treatment.
- Belen Domingo A contented employee, though longing for her husband's affection. She represents women who prioritize family over ambition.
- Tomas (the Janitor) A father of seven, struggling to support his large family. A gold medalist himself, he still believes in the illusion that company loyalty ensures a better future.
- Sally A saleslady and Pastora's "runner," foul-mouthed and constantly in conflict with Emy. She shows how division among workers weakens their cause.

Though each character differs in personality—loyal, ambitious, rebellious, or resigned—they all share one truth: they are underpaid, undervalued, and denied growth while being asked to work harder for the company's progress. Their lives reveal the irony of a "paradise" that is, in truth, a prison of exploitation. Paraisong Parisukat becomes a mirror of society, questioning the cost of blind loyalty, misplaced ambition, and a system that traps workers in an endless cycle of survival.


CHREZELLE CALABIA




The Director IVY GUADALUPE SUMILANG-OBDIANELA
