INTERIM GUIDELINES ON THE PREVENTION, CONTROL, AND MANAGEMENT OF INFLUENZA AND INFLUENZA-LIKE ILLNESS

The **Provincial Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (PESU)** reports a continuing rise in **Influenza-like Illness (ILI)** cases. Given this upward trend, all health offices and school health personnel are **urged to intensify surveillance and ensure timely reporting**, especially during the transition from the rainy season to the Amihan season when respiratory infections typically increase.

This is in reference to **DOH Department Memorandum No. 2023-0391**;
<https://bit.ly/42Bg7u5> the following actions are directed:

1. Maintain vigilant monitoring and regular reporting of ILI cases
2. Watch for clustering of cases, particularly in schools and other closed settings.
3. Submit a health signals report for any suspected clustering or unusual increase in cases
4. Ensure complete documentation (name, age, symptoms, date onset, class/section)
5. Implement preventive measures such as health education, environment sanitation and classroom disinfection,
6. Coordinate and report findings to your respective **City Epidemiology and Surveillance Units (CESU)** or the **Provincial Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (PESU)**
