The Association of Science and Mathematics Educators of Philippine Private Schools (ASMEPPS) Inc. will conduct the 12th National Battle of Math and Science Champions, to be held at Easter College, Easter Road, Guisad, Baguio City, on February 20-21, 2026.

The two-day activity will cover all contest categories in Science and Mathematics, aiming to develop knowledge and skills through friendly competitions and activities among science and math enthusiasts. With the theme, ASMEPPS Empowering Future Innovators: Strengthening Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Education for a Sustainable World, the contest seeks to showcase the scientific and mathematical talents and abilities of learners and coaches, promote academic excellence, and foster intellectual camaraderie and partnerships among participants.
