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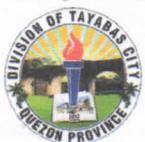

RESEARCH PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

- Step 1. Go over the **Division Research Agenda** (*Please see Enclosure 1*) and look for a possible research topic that sounds interesting to you.
- Step 2. Start writing proposal for submission to the School Research Committee (SRC) Chairperson.
- The research proposal must be typed in and double spaced on A4 size bond paper, with 1-inch margin at all sides.
 - Text should be in 12-font, Arial font style.
 - In-text citations, reference list and tables must follow the APA citation style, 7th edition.
- Step 3. The submitted research proposal must be reviewed by the SRC.
- Step 4. The Approval Sheet (*Please see Enclosure 3*) must be duly signed by the SRC prior to uploading to the given link.
- Step 5. Uploaded research proposals shall undergo blind peer review within the Division.
