

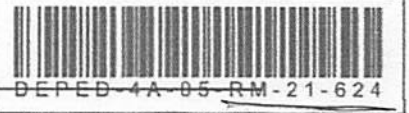

1. This Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) announces the conduct of the Use of Filipino Sign Language Workshop on December 13-15, 2021 on the venue to be announced on the separate memorandum.
2. The objective of this activity is to capacitate the receiving teachers and special education teachers on the use of Filipino sign language which will be helpful in handling learners with hearing impairment. Further, since this is a virtual engagement, all interested parents, caregivers and community helpers handling learners with hearing impairment are encouraged to attend.
3. A registration link shall be provided to ensure that only official participants are on the platform.
4. Facilitators who are fully vaccinated and who will be reporting onsite may bring their vaccination cards.
5. Transportation and incidental allowances of the facilitators shall be charged against school MOOE or local fund, whichever is available.
6. Since this is a face-to-face engagement, the Regional Training Management Team shall ensure that the conduct of this workshop must strictly adhere to the health protocols set by the Region and the IATF.
