 - c. provide a meaningful learning experience for learners in journalism as a career or those who intend to use journalistic skills in their chosen careers;
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media;
 - e. introduce the new events in the upcoming NSPC events; and
 - f. showcase the campus journalistic skills of learners across Tayabas City

- i. Column Writing (Exhibition Only)

4. The Official delegation from each identified school shall consist of 18 Campus Journalists, a total of 3 participants for each category in both English and Filipino and overall total of 108 contestants from SDO Tayabas City.

5. In preparation for the RSPC, the 6th Division Cliniquing for Campus Journalists is scheduled on February 10-11 and 15-17, 2022 (A separate Memo will be released for the cliniquing).


