The Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC) and the SDRC Secretariat shall be in-charge in the process of identifying which articles shall be published in both the The Trajectory and the E-Site or in either of the 2. Double blind review shall be conducted; self-citations in any part of the article/s is highly discouraged.

4. Authors/writers shall be given certificate of recognition.

5. Attached are Enclosure 1 – Guidelines for Submission, Enclosure 2 – Templates for submission, Indicative Timeline of Activities, and Rubrics for evaluation of content and style.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. The following parts shall be included:

A. Introduction including legal and theoretical bases, objectives of the research as well as description on how it contributes/d to the attainment of the goals of Sulong EduKalidad;

B. Strategies / methods / steps used in implementing the research initiative, advocacy or innovation;

C. Discussion of the perceived and actual results/outcomes/impact of the advocacy/ initiative / innovation, including insights gained;

D. Concluding paragraph which may include recommendations; and

E. References written in APA style

2. Article shall not exceed 1500 words with title limited to 10 words. It must be accompanied by at least one to a maximum of four high-resolution photos, in PNG or JPEG format, to be sent as attachment;

3. The research article should be typed and double-spaced on an A4-sized paper, with 1-inch margin on all sides. Texts should be in 12 pt. Arial font. In-text citation and reference list must follow the APA citation style 6th edition format.

3. Submissions must use the given template. The rubric for content and style is for your perusal. (Enclosure 2: Annexes 1 and 2)

4. Passing score is 85%.

4. All articles shall be submitted to luzviminda.saludares@deped.gov.ph using deped email , with the subject: SDO Tayabas Research Publication.

5. Writer/s' details form must be accomplished and included in the submission.
