- 1. In reference with PCW Memorandum Circular No.2023-01 re: Guide for the 2023 National Women's Month Celebration, the City Schools Division of the City of Tayabas joins the nation in the observance of the 2023 National Women's Month Celebration with the theme "WE: for gender equality and inclusive society" which is both a positive affirmation and a call for action. In line with this, all schools are encouraged to conduct a monthlong celebration on March 1-31, 2023.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. Inform and engage all personnel of SDO Tayabas on strengthening the implementation of Magna Carta for Women (Republic Act 9710);
 - b. Create and facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD);
 - c. Recognize women's achievement and contribution in education and in the community; and
 - d. Inspire and empower women to be agents of change.
- 3. To cap the six-year recurring theme, 2023-2028, the 2023 NMC will focus on the subtheme: "DigitALL: Innovation and technology for gender equality".
- 4. The following are suggested activities which could be done in school:
 - a. Sharing about NMC in flag raising ceremonies
 - b. Production/reproduction of information materials about agency services for women
 - c. Posting/display of the official 2023 NMC banner
 - d. Joining the #purpleWednesday initiative
 - e. Providing "Serbisyo Para kay Juana" activities
 - f. Conducting fora, workshops, lectures, contests, or similar activities
 - g. Using of the official collateral designs released by PCW
