2022 SDO CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

To: OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Heads, Unit/Section All Others Concerned

1. With reference to PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2022-01 re: Guide for 2022 National Women's Month Celebration, the City Schools Division of the City Tayabas joins the nation in the observance of the 2022 National Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) with the theme: **"WE Make CHANGE Work for Women"** which highlights the empowerment of women as harbingers of change that anchored on "malasakit at pagbabago." In line with this, all schools are encouraged to conduct a monthlong celebration on March 1 – 31, 2022.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. inform and engage all personnel of SDO Tayabas on strengthening the implementation of Magna Carta for Women (Republic Act 9710);
- b. Create and facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD);
- c. Recognize women's achievement and contribution in education and in the community; and
- d. Inspire and empower women to be agents of change

3. To cap the six-year recurring theme, the 2022 NWMC will focus on the subtheme: *Agenda ng Kababaihan, Tungo sa Kaunlaran*.

- 4. The following are the suggested activities which could be done in the school:
 - a. Sharing about NWMC in Flag Raising Ceremonies
 - b. Production/Reproduction of information materials about agency services for women
 - c. Posting/Displaying of the official 2022 NWMC banner
 - d. Joining the #Purple Monday initiative
 - e. Providing "Serbisyo para kay Juana" activities
 - f. Conducting fora, workshops, lectures, contests, or similar activities
 - g. Using of the official collateral designs released by PCW
 - h. Giving tribute to women for their significant contribution in education and in the community

5. As part of the advocacy campaign, all schools are also encouraged to conduct a Kick-off activity to commence the start of the advocacy activities.
