1. In line with the celebration of Division Mathematics Month, Pi Day, and the International Day of Mathematics, the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct the **Tayabas Mathematics Quest 2026** on **March 13, 2026** at **Tayabas East Central School**.
2. The **Tayabas Mathematics Quest 2026** aims to:
 - a. Promote excellence in mathematics among young learners;
 - b. Provide a platform for students to apply their mathematical skills in a competitive and engaging environment;
 - c. Strengthen Tayabas City's standing as a hub for mathematics education; and
 - d. Foster a culture of analytical thinking, problem-solving, and academic growth.
3. The competition is open to **elementary and secondary school learners** from both public and private schools. Please refer to the attached enclosure for the guidelines and mechanics.
4. Expenses related to this activity shall be charged to local or school funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is highly encouraged.

Eligibility and Participation

1. The Tayabas Mathematics Quest 2026 is a mathematics competition for learners in the City Division of Tayabas City. It is open to all public and private school learners from Grade 1 to Grade 12.
5. Participants must wear school uniforms and wear their duly signed identification cards.
6. Registration shall be completed online on or before March 12, 2026, via a link that will be provided at a later date.
7. Participants must arrive at the venue at least one hour before the official start of the event.
8. Participants must be accompanied by a teacher or coach during the competition.

Scope and Coverage

1. Grade 1 participants will be given questions on addition and subtraction, while Grades 2 and 3 will have questions on addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
2. For the Individual and Team Events (Grades 4 to 12), questions will cover:
 - a. Competencies from Quarters 1 to 3 of the current grade level.
 - b. Competencies from the previous grade level.
3. Questions will not be categorized into easy, average, and difficult.

General Guidelines and Mechanics

1. The competition consists of a paper and pencil test.
2. The test should be answered in 60 minutes.
3. The test consists of multiple-choice items and open-ended questions.
4. For multiple choice items, answers may be the letter of the chosen answer, the computed answer, or both the letter and the computed answer.
5. For open-ended items, answers should be written complete with appropriate units, unless the unit is already stated in the question, written with the correct number of decimal places, if required, and in the simplest form, where applicable.
6. Scores will be tallied to determine the winners:
 - a. The participant with the highest score shall be declared Champion.
 - b. The participant with the second-highest score shall be declared Second Place.

- c. The participant with the third-highest score shall be declared Third Place.
7. In case of a tie, pre-identified items answered correctly by the participant will be declared the winner.
8. Only the official participant may raise a complaint, protest, or clarification.
9. The decision of the Organizing Committee shall be deemed final and irrevocable.

Prizes and Recognition

- Winning participants shall receive a Certificate of Recognition and a medal.
- Teacher-coaches of winning participants shall receive a Certificate of Recognition.
