

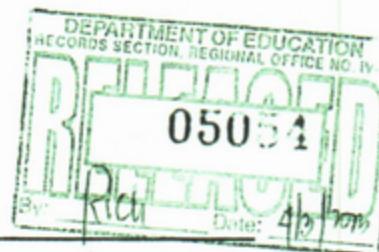

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. This Office hereby disseminates the letter received from PHILSTAR Media Group relative to its Learning Experience Acquired through Reading Newspapers (LEARN) program. This office, through the Education Support Services Division, notes and considers its implication to the region's learning objectives.
2. This dissemination is subject to the condition under Republic Act No. 5546 (Ganzon Law), particularly its Section 1 to read as follows:

"Sec. 1. The sale of tickets and/or the collection of contributions in any form whatsoever, by any person for any project or purpose, whether voluntary or otherwise, from school children, students, and teachers of public and private schools, colleges and universities is hereby prohibited: Provided, However, That this prohibition shall not cover membership fees of school children and students in the Red Cross, the girl scouts of the Philippines and the boy scouts of the Philippines: Provided, Finally, That this prohibition shall not cover the contributions of parents and other donors for the support of barrio high schools."

3. Participation of public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption of classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled "Instituting measures to increase engaged time-on-task and ensuring compliance therewith".
4. The partnership must adhere to a voluntary basis.
5. Attached hereto are the project details and guidance for engagement.

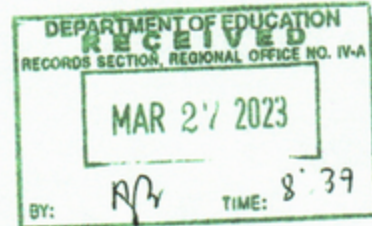
