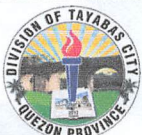

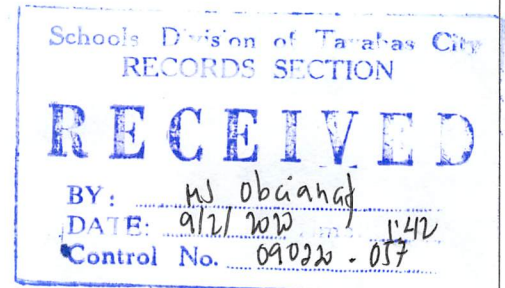

It is with great pride and enthusiasm to inform you, that the current elected officials of the local government unit (LGU) of the City of Tayabas headed by Mayor ERNIDA AGPI-REYNOSO are unanimous in recognizing the utmost importance of EDUCATION, and one of the top priorities of the duly adopted 10 Point ++ Executive - Legislative Agenda (ELA) 2020-2022 include the establishment of the proposed City College of Tayabas (CCT). 
