### CONDUCT OF ACTIVITIES FOR WOMEN WITH DISABILITIES DAY

1. With reference to **Proclamation No. 744**, which declares the last Monday of March every year as **Women with Disabilities Day**, and **PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2026-02** on the **2026 National Womens Month Celebration (NWMC)** as adopted in **DepEd Memorandum No. 010, s. 2026** and as reiterated on **Regional Memorandum No. 211 s. 2026 – Conduct of Activities in Support for Women with Disabilities Day**, schools are enjoined to conduct activities in support of women with disabilities.
2. These activities aim to reaffirm the Department's commitment to promoting the rights, dignity, inclusion and meaningful participation of women with disabilities within the organization.
3. Schools may conduct activities not limited to the following:

  - d. Disability sensitivity and gender awareness session.
  - e. Social media advocacy campaign through the official DepEd Tayo pages.


financial policies and regulations. Such expenses may likewise be reflected in the GAD Accomplishment Reports.


