
- 1. 

2020 COOP and Financial Literacy Month Celebrations

Guidelines

I. General Guidelines

- 1. A participant is qualified to compete in any contests.
- 2. The contest is open to teachers and learners of the City Schools Division of the City of Tayabas.
- 3. Contestants are required to register online on the link indicated in this Division Memorandum and they are expected to complete the information needed.
- 4. The link for the launching and awarding programs will be provided to the participants and guests.
- 5. The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.
- 6. Interested participants shall submit their entries in pdf format on or before December 3, 2020 thru this link: https://tinyurl.com/2020cooperativecontest
- 7. Prize to be awarded is per entry, meaning if more than one person is involved in the work, then the prize will be shared between them.
- 8. The judging of all contest categories will be on December 11, 2020
- 9. All winning and non-winning entries will become properties of the City Cooperative Development Office of the City of Tayabas and will be used for its related activities and undertakings.
- 10. Decisions of the Board of Judges are final.
- 11. Announcement of results and awarding of top three (3) winners will be conducted via online during the awarding ceremony.
- 12. Winners will receive online notification.
- 13. All schools of the participating teachers and learners in the different contest categories will receive 1 box of bond paper from the Office of the City Cooperative Development Office.
- 14. Entries with 4th to 33rd ranks upon judging will be entitled to receive consolation prize.

II. Specific Guidelines

A. Comics Making Contest (For Teachers)

- 1. The comics should revolve around the National Cooperative Month Theme: Cooperatives Amidst Pandemic, Stand for Resiliency, Strive for Sustainability.
- 2. Filipino, English or both could be used to present dialogues in the comics.
- 3. Contestants should submit one colored entry containing a minimum of four to six frames drawn on one standard-sized using A4 (210 x 297mm) size bond paper (hard copy) in not less than 10 pages with at least 300 dpi.
- 4. Each participant in this contest category should submit ONE entry only.
- 5. Contestants are encouraged to create original artwork, characters and story that are not yet published in any form.
- 6. Manually and digitally drawn work are acceptable. Manually drawn must be scanned and save in the prescribed format.
- 7. The use of excessive or overly violent, sexual, offensive themes, graphics and language will not be accepted.
- 8. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Relevance to the Theme 20%
Artistry (overall quality of illustration, 30%
coloring, shading, line detail, background, etc.)

Story (Appeal to human interest, grammar and 30%

flow, originality & creativity)









Overall impact of work 20% Total 100%

9. The winners will receive the following prize:

1st Place – Php 5,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school 2nd Place – Php 4,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school 3rd Place – Php 3,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school

10. Non-winners will receive consolation prize of Php 500.00 and a Certificate of Participation

B. Vlog Making Contest (For High School Students)

- 1. The contest is open to all enrolled public and private high school students of the SDO Tayabas City.
- 2. School head must choose a teacher-coach who will select the contestant/s for this contest.
- 3. Each entry shall be a short story that is focused mainly on contribution and impact of Cooperatives in the life of ordinary Filipinos.
- 4. Vlog entries shall focus on the National Cooperative Month Theme: Cooperatives Amidst Pandemic, Stand for Resiliency, Strive for Sustainability.
- 5. The length of the video must not exceed 3 minutes.
- 6. All entries must be submitted in an MP4 format with 3 lead characters.
- 7. The Vlog entries must be mainly in Filipino or English or both.
- 8. Any kind of multimedia / video-editing software (Adobe Premiere, Sony Vegas Pro, Proshow Producer, Movie Maker, Adobe after Effects, Particle Illusion, etc.) can be used. The entry must be an original work.
- 9. The contestants are 100% responsible for all the production costs of the video.
- 10. All submission must not violate copyright laws or use brand names/logos.
- 12. Vloggers must give credits to the composers and songs used in the video.
- 13. Use of disrespectful language or personal attack on people or organization will automatically disqualify entries.
- 14. The entries will be uploaded in the official FB page of the City Cooperative Development Office on December 5 to 0, 2020 for online voting through the number of reactions (hearts only) an entry received.

 $1^{\rm st}$ Place – Php 5,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school $2^{\rm nd}$ Place – Php 4,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school $3^{\rm rd}$ Place – Php 3,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school

17. Non-winners will receive consolation prize of Php 500.00 and a Certificate of Participation

C. Cooperative-based Module Making Contest (For Teachers)

1. Learning module must be subdivided into microteaching sessions. An entire module may have a total duration of 3 weeks. One-week duration for each









- microlearning session that can be delivered through modular distance learning delivery.
- 2. The use of cooperative resource materials is highly encouraged. Participants may ask copies (hard and/or soft) of Cooperative Resource Materials from the Office of the City Cooperative Development Office.
- 3. The module should follow the standard format and elements of ADM issued by the Department of Education. Participants may ask Mr. Sancho C. Calatrava and/or Generosa Zubieta for the format.
- 4. The following should also be considered in developing the module.

• Structure and Sequence

- Lessons shall be arranged from simple to complex.
- > Size of the letters and sentences shall be appropriate to the target learners.
- Presentation shall be engaging and interesting.

Content

- ➤ It shall consider learners context, situations, needs and capabilities
- ➤ It shall adhere to the social content guidelines
- ➤ It shall be learner-centered and shall promote 21st century skills.

Language

- Material shall use English as the language of instruction.
- ➤ It shall use appropriate language and vocabulary.
- > The length of the sentences, paragraphs shall be age-appropriate.

• Illustrations

- > Illustrations shall adhere to the Social Content Guidelines.
- Filipino characters (if applicable) shall be the subject of illustration.
- ➤ People, animals, places, and objects shall be appropriate to the age, grade level and context of the learners.
- > Illustrations shall clarify and/or enhance concepts.
- > Illustrations and visuals shall be gender and culture sensitive.
- Cover art shall bear the official logos of LGU Tayabas, City Cooperative Development Office and City Schools Division of Tayabas City.
- 5. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

- 7. Non-winners will receive consolation prize of Php 500.00 and a Certificate of Participation

D. Coloring Contest

- 1. The contest is open to all enrolled public and private grades 4 to 6 learners of the SDO Tayabas.
- 2. School head must choose a teacher-coach who will select the contestant/s for this contest.
- 3. The contest will be on December 11, 2020 at Casa Comunidad from 8:00 AM to 12:00 NN.
- 4. Only one entry per participant will be allowed.
- 5. Only colored pencil or crayons shall be used, which will be provided by the participants.
- 6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:









Accuracy of color to real image	30 %
Overall attractiveness of picture	30 %
Creativity	20%
Color of Scheme	20%
Total	100%

- 7. The winners will receive the following prize:

 1st Place Php 2,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school

 2nd Place Php 1,500.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school
- 8. Non-winners will receive consolation prize of Php 300.00 and a Certificate of Participation

3rd Place - Php 1,000.00 plus Certificate and 1box of bond paper for the school
