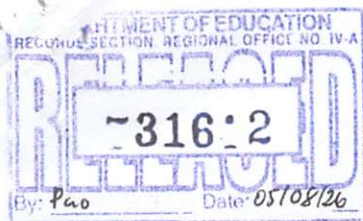

DISSEMINATION AND PROMOTION OF THE BAGONG PILIPINAS MERIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (BPMSP)

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. The Bagong Pilipinas Merit Scholarship Program (BPMSP) is a merit-based scholarship program intended for high-performing Senior High School students across the country. The program aims to support deserving learners who wish to pursue further studies either in higher education or technical-vocational fields.
2. Under this program, qualified students may enroll in degree programs recognized by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through participating colleges and universities, or in priority diploma programs identified by the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) through registered training institutions. These programs are aligned with national priorities to address workforce demands, strengthen hard-to-fill occupations, and contribute to national development under the Bagong Pilipinas agenda.
3. In this regard, all Schools Division Offices are hereby requested to:
 - a. Disseminate information about the BPMSP to all public and private Senior High Schools within their respective jurisdictions;
 - b. Encourage eligible and high-performing learners to apply for the scholarship program;
 - c. Assign guidance counselor/coordinator to assist in the identification and endorsement of qualified applicants; and
 - d. Ensure proper guidance is provided to interested students regarding program options and application procedures.
