- a. ensure that school heads fully implement the proposed IS Plan for June 2022 with focus on the implementation of K to 12 curriculum, utilization of assessment results (for schools and learning centers), development and checking of schools' assessment tools (formative and summative), conduct of PhilIRI Post Test, post assessment for numeracy, intervention programs, utilization of MG LAS, SPED and ALS PPAs, conduct of Post Test for ECD, school's CI Project and conduct of research, and validation of ALS learners' portfolio;
 - b. generate feedback from school heads and teachers on the implementation of the intended curriculum;
 - c. provide technical assistance to schools and learning centers; and
 - d. gather information on schools' best practices on curriculum implementation
