For the creation and issuance of Professional Development Information System (PDIS) accounts, teachers are requested to register their details via www.deped.gov.ph/neap/register.html. PDIS accounts of school leaders will be coordinated through subsequent memoranda/advisories.
6. All NEAP SIM Card recipients will receive their top up load (NEAP Package 379). On the other hand, public school teachers who were not given NEAP SIM Cards may opt to have their communications expense reimbursed following the usual procedure for the reimbursement of communications expenses and including a copy or screenshot of his / her registration to any of the programs listed above.
