READINESS OF LEARNING RESOURCES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027

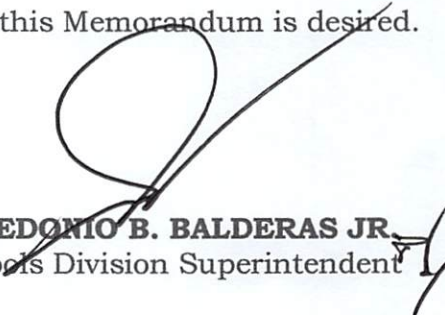

1. Relative to **Regional Memorandum No. 364 s. 2026** dated **June 4, 2026** titled **Readiness of Learning Resources for School Year 2026-2027**, all schools are directed to ensure the readiness, availability and utilization of learning resources to support effective teaching and learning.
2. This aims to:
 - a. ensure the effective and efficient utilization of available learning resources to support quality instruction and learning outcomes;
 - b. provide guidance and support on the appropriate utilization of delivered textbooks and other learning resources as essential instructional materials for teaching and learning; and
 - c. promote equitable access to quality learning resources to all learners.
3. Schools shall primarily utilize the delivered Textbooks (TXs) and Teacher's Manuals (TMs) provided by the Department of Education Central Office. These shall serve as the main instructional resources for classroom instruction.
4. In cases where textbooks and teachers manuals have not yet been delivered schools may utilize available Self- Learning Modules, (SLMs) Transition Learning Resources (Transition LR), Lesson Exemplars (LEs) Learning Activity Sheets (LAS) and Worksheets, Dynamic Learning Program Learning Activity Sheets (DLP- LAS) Teachers Notes, Learning Packets and other approved Supplementary Learning Resources (SLRs) to ensure the continuity of instruction and learning delivery.
5. Also, SDO Tayabas through the Curriculum Implementation Division – Learning Resource Management Section has also delivered Remediation Reading Packages to selected schools identified as needing intervention and support in improving learners reading proficiency. Recipient schools are encouraged to maximize the utilization of these materials to strengthen reading instruction, remediation activities and literacy programs.
6. Schools are also encouraged to promote resource sharing and maximize the use of available learning materials to ensure that no learner is deprived of access to quality learning resources while awaiting the delivery of other instructional materials.

7. The Curriculum Implementation Division through the Learning Area Supervisors, Learning Resource Management Section and other concerned units, shall monitor the utilization, distribution, accessibility, effectiveness of learning resources and provide technical assistance as necessary.
