### DIVISION TRAINING ON ENGLISH PROFICIENCY FOR ELEMENTARY TEACHERS AND WORKSHOP ON VALUES FORMATION FOR GRADES 3 AND 4 LEARNERS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Heads, Public Elementary Schools Heads, Unit/Section All Others Concerned

1. In line with the MATATAG Basic Education Agenda to provide necessary support for teachers to teach better and to strengthen moral development of learners, SDO Tayabas City shall conduct the **Division Training on English Proficiency for Elementary Teachers and Workshop on Values Formation for Grades 3 and 4 Learners on August 10, 2024 (Saturday) at Casa de Comunidad de Tayabas, Brgy. San Roque Zone 1, Tayabas City.** 

2. Organized by the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) in cooperation with the School Governance Operations Division (SGOD) through its Partnership Program, the training will be sponsored by **Create Lasting Impressions (CLI) Training Consultancy and Business Networking International (BNI) Foundation.** 

3. It aims to provide valuable inputs on English Proficiency for teachers and enhance their pedagogical skills so that they can effectively address the current learning needs of Filipino students studying English Language Arts (ELA). It also targets character education of learners.

4. Participants in this activity are 80 Elementary Teachers and 50 Learners. (See attached Lists of Participants.) Teacher participants are expected to arrive at 7:45 AM while learners are expected to be there at 9:30 AM. MOA Signing will be conducted before the training proper. It is reiterated that learner participants should secure parent's consent/permit.

5. The said activity is scheduled on a Saturday to avoid disruption of classes in adherence to DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, and DepEd Office of the Assistant Secretary for Governance and Filed Operations (OASGFO) Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities.

6. The conference meals of the participants will be shouldered by the foundation. They will also distribute tote bag and school supplies to the learners. However, the travel expenses for the training shall be charged against the available School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), and/or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

7. The program management team and the participants shall adhere to the minimum health and safety protocols implemented by the Department of Health (DOH).

8. Given that the activity is a Saturday, identified participants found in **Enclosure 1** shall be entitled to vacation service credits and/or compensatory time off, whichever is applicable, pursuant to DepEd Order 53, s. 2003 and/or CSC-DBM Joint Circulars No. 2, s. 2004 and No. 2-A, s. 2005.
