### 2021 PAMBANSANG BUWAN AT ARAW NG PAGBASA

TO: OIC Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools All Others Concerned

1. In reference to DM-CI-2021-00466 (2021 Pambansang Buwan at Araw ng Pagbasa), SDO Tayabas City's supervisors, school heads, English and Filipino teachers and non-teaching personnel are enjoined to participate in the various activities relative to the national celebration spearheaded by the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) starting with the Orientation for Teachers on the Use of Reading Progress on October 26, 20021 (Additional information on this is on a separate Memo).

2. This celebration aims to:

- a. Orient teachers on the use of reading progress
- b. Promote love for reading among learners
- c. Intensify the Reading Program 3 B's HEART under the Division Umbrella Program on Literacy dubbed Program E-LIVE

3. With this year's theme, "Bawat Bata Bumabasa sa Kabila ng Hamon ng Pandemya", the National Virtual Kick Off livestreamed via DepEd FB Page set on November 8, 2021 shall also be enjoined by all schools and division personnel which will feature a mystery reading ambassador.

4. The PBAP shall culminate with the National Synchronized Story Reading Day on November 26, 2021 at 9:00 AM. All our learners, teaching and non-teaching staff shall drop everything and read for this simultaneous activity.

5. Another national issuance shall be released relative to other activities such as capacity building of teachers as story readers and storytellers, Reading Cup, and Dugtungang Pagbasa.

6. The Regional Webinar on Reading is also scheduled on November 12, 2021. (Regional Memo No.21-485.)

7. All schools and learning centers are enjoined to hold virtual activities as well for elementary and secondary learners. (Please see attachment for the complete list of activities). However, all are likewise encouraged to hold related school activities other than those on the list, to put up streamers for the said Reading Month Celebration, and to conduct activities to capacitate teachers as reading teachers.

- A virtual kick-off shall be held on November 8, 2021, that will feature a mystery reading ambassador. It will be livestreamed via the DepEd Philippines Facebook Page.
- Another issuance shall be released relative to other activities such as the capacity building of teachers as story readers and story tellers, Reading Cup, and *Dugtungang Pagbasa*.
- The PBAP shall culminate with the nationwide synchronized story reading time on November 26, 9:00 am Philippine Standard Time (PST). All our learners, teaching and non-teaching staff shall drop everything and read.

# ACTIVITIES FOR THE PAMBANSANG BUWAN AT ARAW NG PAGBASA

**Orientation for Teachers on the Use of** *Reading Progress.* Regional supervisors and teachers of English and Filipino will be trained on how to use the Reading Progress online application. This is a tool that can help teachers help their learners enhance their reading proficiency and develop love for reading. This is a self-instructional application in which learners can conveniently explore a repository of stories and track their reading progress through the guidance of their teachers. A separate memorandum will be issued for the purpose of this activity.

Virtual Kick Off. On November 8, 2021, a virtual kick-off will start the month-long celebration of the *Pambansang Buwan at Araw ng Pagbasa*. A mystery reading ambassador will be invited to tell a story to young learners and to inspire everyone to develop a genuine love for reading. It will also highlight the launching of the Reading Progress as a teaching-learning tool that can help enhance reading fluency among our learners. The virtual kick-off will be livestreamed via the DepEd FB page.

**Capacity Building on Storytelling.** The Bureau of Learning Delivery, in collaboration with partners in MS Teams, will conduct a virtual capacity building for teachers and parents as part of the virtual kick-off on November 8. It will focus on storytelling techniques that teachers and parents may use to keep learners interested in stories and help them improve comprehension of these stories. Story book writers and professional storytellers will be invited as resource persons for this activity.

Mystery Readers. *Reading ambassadors* will be invited to read to young learners every week during the month of November, focusing on themes such as family, friendship, and love. To engage learners, a variety of interactive and collaborative online applications that are available and accessible to all can be used.

**Dugtungang Pagbasa.** Every week of November, young learners from pre-assigned regions will share stories via the DepEd Philippines FB page. Carefully selected stories will be told through a continuous narration by select learners from different regions. They will also showcase their creativity in interpreting the stories through a multimedia presentation. A more detailed orientation on the process of conducting this activity will be scheduled soon through a separate memorandum.

**Reading Cup.** Reading Cup is a gamified regional reading contest through Reading Progress. This activity aims to assess the reading fluency level of students and showcase exemplar readers across regions. A more detailed orientation on the process of conducting this activity will be scheduled soon through a separate memorandum.

**Reading Challenge.** All teaching and non-teaching personnel of the Department are enjoined to read a book for a week for the month of November. A book sharing activity should also be organized once a week to share the book read for the week. *This activity may be initiated at the regional level.* 

**Reading Family.** Each family is challenged to read at least once a week. Each family is expected to post pictures of this activity through pictures, posters about the story they have read together. *This activity may be initiated at the regional level* 

Araw ng Pagbasa Challenge. This day is the culmination of *Pambansang Buwan ng Pagbasa*. On November 26 at 9:00 am Philippine Standard Time, all learners, teachers, non-teaching personnel, school officials shall observe the nationwide synchronized reading activity. All are enjoined to drop everything and read for at least 15 minutes. At the national level, one reading ambassador will be invited to read a story before a group of learners across the regions.
