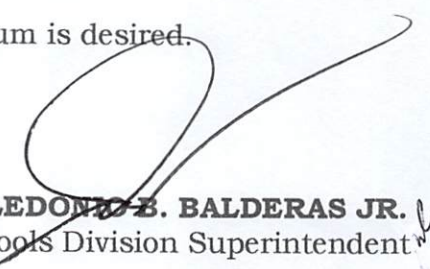

In line with the celebration of the 2026 Cooperative Month, the City Government of Tayabas, through the Tayabas Cooperative Development Office (TCDO), will conduct the **2026 Laboratory Cooperative Youth Camp** on **August 21–22, 2026** at **Ilasan Integrated School, Tayabas City**.

As agreed during our recent coordination meeting and in keeping with our established partnership, we respectfully request the assistance of the Schools Division Office of Tayabas City in identifying and endorsing thirty (30) student participants who are bona fide members of their respective Laboratory Cooperatives within the City of Tayabas.

The official list of participants may be submitted to the Tayabas Cooperative Development Office (TCDO) on or before August 7, 2026 to facilitate the necessary preparations and arrangements for the activity.

To ensure the orderly conduct of the Youth Camp, we likewise request your assistance in informing the endorsed participants of the following:

1. Day 1 Attire: Participants shall wear their official Physical Education (P.E.) uniform.
2. Upon arrival on the first day of the activity, participants shall receive their Youth Camp kits, which include the official T-shirt, tote bag, ballpen, and notebook. The official T-shirt provided by their respective Guardian Cooperative shall be worn by the participants on the second day of the activity.





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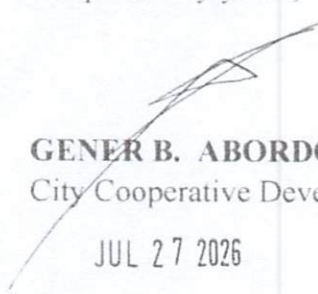
3. Participants are advised to bring their own:
 - Beddings (blanket, pillow, sleeping mat, or other sleeping essentials);
 - Hygiene kit; and
 - Personal medicines, if any.
4. Meals throughout the activity shall be provided by the Tayabas Cooperative Development Office (TCDO). However, participants are requested to bring their own cooking tools or mess kit (e.g., plate, bowl, cup, spoon, and fork) for use during the preparation and serving of their breakfast.
5. The participants shall be divided into five (5) groups during the activity for the conduct of group cooking and other related activities. In support of this activity, there is a total requirement of five (5) portable butane stoves and five (5) butane gas canisters to be utilized by the groups. The assignment and utilization of these materials shall be coordinated by the organizers during the activity.

Attached herewith are the 2026 Laboratory Cooperative Youth Camp Program and other pertinent documents for your reference, dissemination, and appropriate action.

We sincerely appreciate your continued support and partnership in promoting cooperative values, leadership, and youth development among the students of Tayabas City.
