**COOPERATIVE MONTH CELEBRATION GRADE 9 STUDENTS
COOPERATIVE QUIZ BEE**

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS OF IMPLEMENTATION

1. The Quiz Bee shall be held on September 11, 2025, 1:00pm – 3:00pm at Training Room 1, New City Hall, Tayabas City.
2. Contestants must be Grade 9 students enrolled in schools within the City of Tayabas. - Each school may send a maximum of two (2) participants.
3. All questions will pertain exclusively to topics related to cooperatives.
4. The questions will be categorized and assigned point values as follows:

CATEGORY	POINTS	No. of Questions	Total
a. Easy	3	20	60
b. Average	5	14	70
c. Difficult	7	10	70
Total			200 pts.

5. The official set of questions will be provided by the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and will be turned over to the Tayabas Cooperative Development Office (TCDO) in a sealed envelope, which shall be opened only in the presence of the contestants on the day of the Quiz Bee.
6. All questions will be in English.
7. Each question will be read twice by the quizmaster. Contestants may only answer after the question has been read twice. The countdown will begin immediately afterward. Contestants must write their answers in large, bold letters.
8. Contestants will be given ten (10) seconds to answer questions in the easy and average rounds, while difficult and clincher questions will be allotted twenty (20) seconds.
9. Illustration boards, chalk, and erasers will be provided by the office.
10. Contestants must raise their chalk as soon as the allotted time to answer is over.
11. In the event of a tie, three (3) difficult questions will be asked to determine the ranking. If the tie remains, a knockout system will be applied, using questions drawn from the set of clincher questions.
12. Representatives from the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) will serve as judges to determine the accuracy and validity of the contestants' answers.

13. Any protest regarding a question or a questionable answer must be raised immediately to the judges before the next question is read, for prompt resolution. No protests regarding previous questions, answers, or decisions will be entertained.
14. Only the contestant or the official coach is allowed to raise a question or protest.
15. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
16. The winner will receive a certificate and a cash prize. A consolation gift will be given to non-winners.

Prizes:

- a. 1st Place – ₱3,000.00
- b. 2nd Place – ₱2,000.00
- c. 3rd Place – ₱1,000.00
