GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

A. STORIES FOR YOUNG READERS BY YOUNG WRITERS

1. The contest is open to all grade 4 to grade 12 students in public schools. Only the participants with consent from parents or legal guardian are allowed to participate. Submit one (1) entry per school per grade level may not be submitted for another grade level.
2. A writing coach is required in this category. Only one permanent teacher or non-teaching personnel within the same school as the learner's is permitted.
3. The full honor and ownership of the story shall be with the participating learner.
4. The decision of the panel of judges based on the following criteria is final and irrevocable.
5. Winners of this contest who will receive certificate of recognition and prizes.

Criteria	Description	Percentage
Concept	Originality and local flavor	20%
Storytelling Style	Artistic presentation, use of the literary device (idioms, figures of speech) appropriate tone of the story, story progression, utilization of character, effective use of dialog.	40%
Development of the Theme	Clarity of the theme, effective presentation, and treatment of competency, appropriateness to grade level.	25%
Presentation Standards	Spelling, punctuation, grammar, usage, orthographic compliance, styling	15%

B. WORDLESS STORYBOOKS BY YOUNG ARTISTS

1. The contest is open to all grade 4 to grade 12 students in public schools. Only the participants with consent from parents or legal guardian are allowed to participate. Submit one (1) entry per school per grade level may not be submitted for another grade level.
2. A writing coach is required in this category. Only one permanent teacher or non-teaching personnel within the same school as the learner's is permitted.
3. The full honor and ownership of the story shall be with the participating learner.
4. The decision of the panel of judges based on the following criteria is final and irrevocable.
5. Winners of this contest who will receive certificate of recognition and prizes.

Media/mode of presentation	Use of appropriate media for the story	15%
Technique and Skill	Consistency	25%
Viewer Reception/Overall Design and Artistic Composition	Use of elements and principles of Art	20%

1. The contest is open to all grade 4 to grade 12 students in public schools. Only the participants with consent from parents or legal guardian are allowed to participate.
2. Take a selfie anywhere in the school library or community library hub. Individual or Group photos/groupies is only allowed to submit one (1) entry per school. Share your experience during your visit of not more than 50 words.
3. Invite your friends to heart react to your entry. The more reactions you got the more chances of winning. The score of audience impact will be based on total number of hearts and number of shares on Facebook until November 17, 2023 at 6:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
