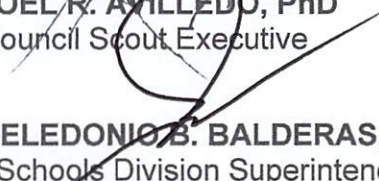

3. **WHO CAN ATTEND:**

 - 3.2. Currently registered and potential Troop Leaders/Outfit Advisors and other adults.
 - 3.3. Parents and guardians. Their activity fee is optional.
4. **ACTIVITY FEE:** An activity fee of **THREE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS ONLY (PhP 350.00)** shall be charged each participant to cover costs of ID, certificate, activity materials and other administrative expenses.
5. **ADVANCED REGISTRATION** can be remitted to the host school or to the Quezon Council, BSP. **ON SITE REGISTRATION** is highly discouraged.
6. **DELEGATION REQUIREMENTS:** Contingents are expected to manage their own funding requirements, packed lunch, transportation requirements to and from the activity site and other personal belonging.
7. All participants must be at the venue on or before 7:30 a.m., already attired for the opening ceremonies.

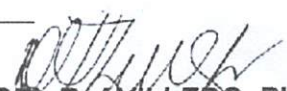
