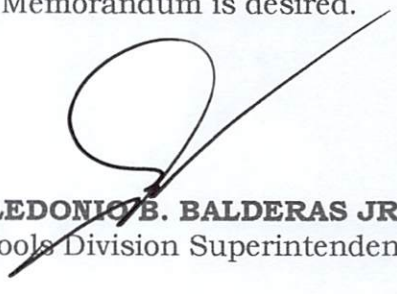

**CAPACITY BUILDING OF TEACHERS ON THE CONTENT, PEDAGOGY, AND
KNOWLEDGE IN FILIPINO, ARALING PANLIPUNAN, MAPEH,
GMRC & VALUES EDUCATION**

1. In reference to **DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2017**, titled **National Adoption and Implementation of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST)**, this Office informs the teachers identified in Enclosure No. 1 of their participation in the Capacity Building of Teachers on the Content, Pedagogy, and Knowledge to be conducted on **September 3–5, 2026**, at **St. Jude Cooperative Hotel and Event Center, Tayabas City**.
2. The three-day capability-building program aims to strengthen teachers' competencies in content knowledge, research-based pedagogy, learner-centered instructional strategies, and assessment practices in support of the effective implementation of the Revised K to 10 Curriculum. It shall highlight the complementary roles of Araling Panlipunan, Filipino, MAPEH, and Values Education in developing learners who are historically informed, culturally responsive, creative, critical-thinking, and responsible citizens through contextualized and culture-based teaching and learning approaches.
3. Specifically, the activity shall cover the following learning sessions:
 - Content Knowledge and Its Application Across Curriculum Areas;
 - Research-Based Pedagogical Approaches;
 - Learner-Centered and Contextualized Instructional Strategies;
 - Inquiry and Investigation in Teaching and Learning;
 - Analysis of Primary and Secondary Sources; and
 - Assessment Practices that Promote Critical and Historical Thinking.
4. The Opening Program shall commence promptly at **8:00 a.m.** at the designated hall. The first meal to be served shall be AM Snack, while the last meal shall be PM Snack.
5. Participants are reminded to bring their laptops and chargers, extension cords, alternative internet sources (e.g., pocket Wi-Fi), and personal medicine kits. They are also required to secure an offline copy of the curriculum guide for their respective grade level and learning area for use during the training sessions.

6. Identified teacher-participants shall be entitled to Vacation Service Credits in accordance with **DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024**, titled **Revised Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers**. Non-teaching and teaching-related personnel whose training dates fall during holidays shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance with **CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004**, titled **Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered**.
7. Travel expenses of participants shall be charged against the respective office's available funds or MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
