**2025 NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH, NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY, AND
WORLD TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATIONS**

1. Pursuant to **Department Memorandum (DM) 067, s. 2025** and to **Presidential Proclamation No. 242** titled Declaring the period from September 5 to October 5 as the National Teachers Month (NTM), as well as **R.A. No. 10743**-An Act Declaring the Fifth day of October of Every Year as the National Teachers Day (NTD), the Schools Division of Tayabas City will lead the activities for the NTM and NTD on **September 5, 2025** and **October 3, 2025**, respectively, at venues to be announced later through an advisory.

2. The celebrations aim to:

- Honor and celebrate those who are in the teaching profession;
- Acknowledge and emphasize the crucial role, loyal service, and dedicated commitment of teachers in developing globally-minded citizens, nurturing families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
- Revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness of the value of teachers in the Philippine society;
- Take the occasion as an opportunity to build the image of teaching as an attractive and fulfilling profession;
- Generate widespread support and assistance for teachers; and
- Express gratitude for the positive influence of teachers on Filipino learners.

3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools in the division are enjoined to follow the synchronized programs, projects and activities. School based celebrations are encouraged, including the recitation of **A Prayer for Teachers or Panalangin Para sa mga Guro** at exactly 3:00 pm, for the entire month.

5. All schools are required to post streamers with the required logo to ensure that the public is aware of the NTM, NTD and WTD celebrations.
6. Expenses relative to NTM and NTD celebrations shall be charged to local funds, PTA funds and other sources available subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. This is also subject to the No Collection Policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 also known as an Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law), issued in **DO 19, s. 2008**, and reiterated in **DM No. 041, s. 2024**.
7. Participation of teachers and learners from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of **Deped Order (DO) No 12, s. 2025**-Multi Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities and **DO 9, s. 2025**-Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time -on -Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on/off campus activities stated in **DO 66, s. 2021**.
8. All schools are required to submit three (3) photo collage of accomplishment weekly every Friday for division posting to ensure that the public is aware of NTM, NTD and WTD celebrations.

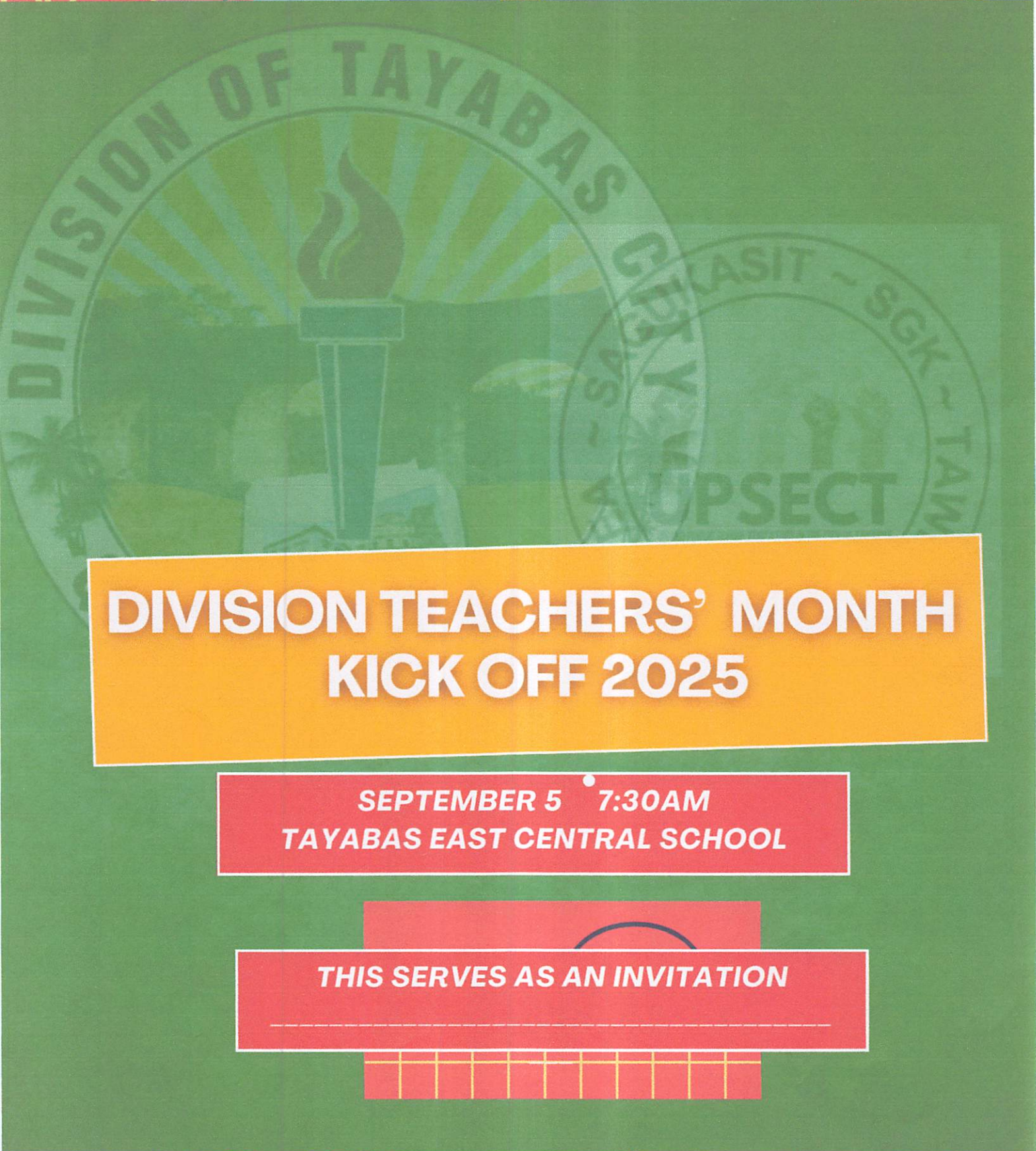

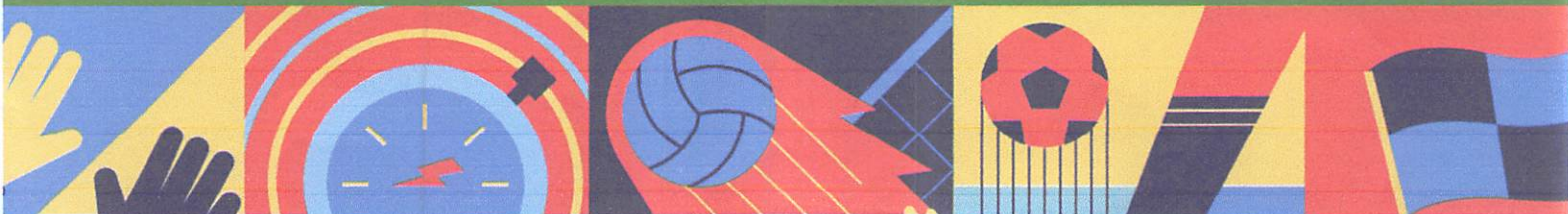
