- d. Output must be submitted 15 MINUTES after the competition via <u>cpu@deped.gov.ph</u>
- e. File name format should follow POSTER_REGION_#. (POSTER_REGION_I)
- f. Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.



- g. Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.
- h. Participants shall provide $\frac{1}{2}$ size illustration board and must use the white background in vertical background.
- i. The medium for visual artistry shall only be limited to oil pastel and shall be provided by the contestant.

- g. Entries should be in Filipino, encoded, double-spaced, with a minimum of 1,500 words and maximum of 3,000 words.
- h. Finished outputs should not contain label or name that may identify the region.
- i. The essay must be original. If the submitted essay is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.

- a. The video essay contest is a short video competition. Further instructions shall be given during the orientation.
- a. One (1) student-participant per region is allowed.
- b. The video essay should run for a minimum length of 5 minutes and maximum length of 8 minutes.
- c. The video essay should have a title.
- d. The content of the video essay must be anchored on the theme "New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan!",

- e. Videos should be encoded on commonly known video file compressions/formats such as .mp4, .avi, and .mkv.
- f. Finished outputs should not contain label or name that may identify the region.
- g. Entries must be submitted to <u>cpu@deped.gov.ph</u> by December 17, 2021, using the Coaches' official DepEd email address.
- h. A Google Drive link may also be used to submit large file formats. In the event that the link is broken/defective or not accessible, submitted entry will no longer be included in the competition.
- i. File name format should follow VIDEOESSAY_REGION_#. (VIDEOESSAY_REGION_I)
- j. All entries shall be considered property of the CPU-DepEd and may be used by the Unit for publication and any other legal purpose.
- k.
