ASAL SA ARAL PROGRAM (ARAL-SALOOB: VALUES INTEGRATION IN ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING)

- 1. The Department of Education continues to strengthen Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) as a flagship program to address learning losses and improve literacy and numeracy among learners. However, academic competence must also be accompanied by moral character, discipline, and values formation to produce holistic, well-rounded, and future-ready Filipino learners. In line with the 1987 Philippine Constitution (Article XIV, Section 3[2]), Republic Act No. 11476 or the GMRC and Values Education Act, Republic Act No. 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, and DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2019, the ASAL sa ARAL Program (Aral-Saloob: Values Integration in Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning) integrates GMRC and Values Education into ARAL sessions to ensure that learners not only recover academically but also grow in values and character. This integration underscores that academic success and moral responsibility must work in tandem in nation-building.
- 2. This initiative aims to integrate values/character formation (ASAL) into literacy, numeracy, and comprehension activities under the ARAL Program; develop academically skilled and values-oriented learners who are reflective, disciplined, and socially responsible; instill in learners the monthly core values/themes (e.g., honesty, discipline, patriotism, compassion) while improving reading and numeracy skills; and produce learners who are makababasa, makakakuwenta, makauunawa, at magiging modelong mag-aaral—both academically competent and morally grounded.

Program Framework: ASAL sa ARAL Integration

(Aral-Saloob: Values Integration in Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning)

ARAL Academic Focus	ASAL Values/GMRC Integration	Sample Learner Outcome
Makababasa (Reading Literacy)	Pagmamahal sa Diyos at Bayan – Using reading passages that promote faith, patriotism, and national identity.	Learner reads and reflects on stories of national heroes and saints, relating values to personal life.
Makakakuwenta (Numeracy)	Katapatan at Pananagutan – Emphasizing honesty in computation and responsibility in completing tasks.	Learner solves math problems with accuracy and shows integrity during activities.
Makauunawa (Comprehension & Critical Thinking)	Pangangalaga sa Kapaligiran at Pagmamalasakit sa Kapwa – Understanding texts and issues related to stewardship and empathy.	Learner interprets texts about environmental care or helping others, applying them in real-life decisions.
Magiging Modelong Mag-aaral (Good Study Habits & Character)	Disiplina, Pakikipagkapwa, at Bayanihan – Practicing discipline, respect, and collaboration in learning.	Learner demonstrates punctuality, respect for teachers/peers, and willingness to help classmates.







Mechanics of Implementation

a. Nomination and Selection

Each class adviser/tutor shall recommend **one (1) or more learners** per month who best exemplify the prescribed monthly value. To encourage wider participation and the development of core values among learners, no strict limit shall be imposed on the number of nominees. Nominations shall be reviewed and validated by **the School Selection Committee**, composed of the School Head, School Guidance Coordinator, and designated teacher representatives.

b. Criteria for Evaluation

The School Selection Committee shall use the **Nomination Form for Monthly Core Values Awardee** (Enclosure 3) as reference in determining awardees.

c. Awarding

Recognition of awardees shall be conducted during the **first Monday Flag Ceremony of the succeeding month** (e.g., July awardees will be recognized on the first Monday of August). Each awardee shall receive a **Certificate of Recognition** duly signed by the School Head. Schools may also provide simple tokens (e.g., bookmarks, medals, ribbons) at their discretion, subject to availability of resources.

d. Means of Verification (MOVs)

The following MOVs shall be prepared and compiled by the school:

- 1. Duly signed **Nomination Form** by the class adviser/tutor;
- Documentation of the selection process (short narrative or minutes of meeting);
- 3. Photo and/or video documentation of the flag ceremony awarding;
- Publication or posting of awardees in the official school Facebook page and/or bulletin board;
- 5. Copy of the Certificate of Recognition.

d. Documentation and Reporting

Schools shall maintain a **Monthly Recognition Portfolio** (hard copy or electronic file) containing all required MOVs. A **consolidated list of monthly awardees** shall be submitted to the Schools Division Office, through the CID, at the end of every quarter for monitoring and validation. e. Monitoring and Evaluation

School Heads shall prepare quarterly reports of activities with supporting MOVs. The Division Office shall monitor implementation through school visits, online monitoring of postings, and submitted reports.
