**SIMULTANEOUS LAUNCH OF ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE
LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM**

1. All public elementary and secondary schools are directed to simultaneously conduct the **Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program Launch** on **September 15, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. onwards** at **Buenaventura Alandy National High School** to drum up awareness and mobilize support for this learning initiative.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. promote understanding of the ARAL Program as a key initiative to address learning losses and gaps;
 - b. build partnerships among teachers, tutors, learners, parents, and stakeholders in supporting academic recovery; and
 - c. highlight school-level strategies and innovations that ensure accessible and inclusive learning for all children.
