**TRAINING WORKSHOP FOR ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM: "EMPOWERING ALS EDUCATORS: FOSTERING ENGAGEMENT AND EXCELLENCE THROUGH INNOVATIVE TEACHING APPROACHES"**

1. In line with the Department of Education's commitment to enhance the quality and inclusivity of the Alternative Learning System (ALS), the Schools Division of the City of Tayabas through Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct a **Training Workshop for ALS Teachers with the theme: "Empowering ALS Educators: Fostering Engagement and Excellence through Innovative Teaching Approaches"** on **October 4, 6, 11 and 13, 2025**, venue and final list of participants will be issued on a separate advisory.
2. This initiative aims to strengthen the competencies of ALS implementers in designing and delivering innovative, learner-centered strategies that will improve learner engagement, retention, and overall program effectiveness. Specifically, the training workshop aims to:

  - b. Enhance educators' capacity in using flexible, inclusive, and technology-driven approaches to engage diverse ALS learners;
  - c. Foster collaboration among ALS implementers in developing contextualized learning resources and strategies; and
  - d. Strengthen monitoring and assessment practices to ensure quality ALS program delivery.
3. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity, including meals, training materials, and other incidental expenses, shall be charged against ALS Program Support Funds/local funds, subject to existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
