REITERATION OF MULTI-YEAR IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES ON THE SCHOOL CALENDAR AND ACTIVITIES

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Heads, Unit/Section All Others Concerned

- 1. In reference to the **DepEd Order No. 012, s. 2025** titled **Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities**, this Office reiterates the above subject to effectively and efficiently implement school activities and maximize instructional time, cognizant of the goals and objectives of the Eight-Point Socioeconomic Agenda of President Ferdinand R Marcos Jr., and the Five-Point Reform Agenda of DepEd.
- 2. The Office reminds the following general guidelines anchored on DepEd Order No. 012, s. 2025
 - a. Learning delivery modalities
 - 1. The in-person learning delivery modality shall remain the primary learning delivery modality in all schools.
 - 2. In the event of a declaration of suspension or cancellation of inperson classes by authorized offices due to emergencies and hazards, as stipulated in DO 22, s. 2024, Revised Guidelines on Class and Work Suspension in Schools During Disasters and Emergencies, schools and CLCs shall automatically implement EiE-ADM, following their respective Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LSCP) through Distance Learning Delivery Modalities (DLDMs), whether Modular Distance Learning (MDL), Online Distance Learning (ODL), TV-Based Instruction (TVI), Radio-Based Instruction (RBI), or blended learning.

b. Co-curricular activities

1. Co-curricular activities shall be conducted on class days, preferably after school hours. However, schools have the flexibility to reduce the standard time allotment for each learning group by up to ten (10) minutes once every two weeks to conduct co-curricular activities.

- 2. Celebrations and observances indicated in Enclosure 3 may be integrated into co-curricular activities, provided they are deemed reasonable and appropriate, reinforce the attainment of target learning competencies, and do not compromise the total number of class days.
- c. School health and nutrition activities and services
 - 1. Schools shall provide learners with access to health and nutrition services throughout the school year, following established guidelines and in coordination with local partners. These services include medical, dental, nursing, and immunization services; nutrition services such as school-based feeding, nutritional assessments, and micronutrient supplementation; and mental health services, including psychosocial assessments, mental health first aid, psychological first aid, and guidance and counseling.
- 3. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
