## EMERGENCY ACTIVATION OF THE DIVISION DRRM EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER AND SCHOOL DRRM TEAM IN PREPARATION FOR TROPICAL CYCLONE ODETTE

To: OIC - Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Heads, Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Heads, Unit/Section All Others Concerned

1. In compliance to DepEd Order No. 33 s. 2021 also known as the School-Based Disaster Preparedness and Response Measures for Tropical Cyclones, Flooding, Other Weather-Related Disturbances and Calamities, the Schools Division Office of the City of Tayabas hereby ACTIVATES the Division Disaster <u>Risk Reduction and Management – Emergency Operations Center</u> and <u>all the</u> <u>School DRRM Team</u> in preparation for the TROPICAL CYCLONE ODETTE which is expected to approach the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) from December 15, 2021 – December 18, 2021.

2. All School Heads are instructed to review existing instructions stipulated in DepEd Order No. 33 s. 2021 specifically Enclosure Nos. 1 - 4. Daily monitoring of compliance from December 14, 2021 – December 18, 2021 will be facilitated by the SGOD - Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Section.

3. All School DRRM Coordinators including their respective alternates shall be reachable within 24 hours until such time that the Tropical Cyclone has been declared by the NDRRMC Coordinating Office as outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility.
