SECOND DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP SERIES FOR CAMPUS JOURNALISTS

1. Pursuant to **Republic Act (RA) No. 7079**, also known as the **Campus Journalism Act of 1991**, and in preparation to the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) and Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC), this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall conduct the **Second Division Training-Workshop Series on Campus Journalism for Campus Journalists** in **Tayabas East Central School**, and **Tayabas West Central School I**, on **October 17 and 21, 2025**, respectively.

2. The activity aims to:

- demonstrate understanding of journalism through skillful execution in various platforms (i.e., print, broadcast, online);
- recognize the role of journalism in advocating for social consciousness and environmental awareness;
- promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism;
- foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through collaboration and sharing of best practices; and
- provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.

3. Participants in this activity are Campus Journalists and other interested students of the Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) in both elementary and secondary levels and select Officers of the Division Association of School Paper Advisers (DASPA) who will serve as Technical Working Group (TWG). The school may register not more than two journalists per individual category and not more than two teams in group category. The list of participants shall be submitted on or before October 15, 2025 until 5:00 PM through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/JournalismTraining2025>.

4. There will be **NO Registration Fee**. Participants may bring their packed snacks, notebook, bond paper, pen, pencil, digital camera, laptop, printer, whichever is needed in a particular category.

5. Attached is the schedule of the Training – Workshops.
6. The program management team and the participants shall adhere to the minimum health and safety protocols implemented by the Department of Health (DOH).
7. Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2015 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*, and DepEd Office of the Assistant Secretary for Governance and Field Operations (OASGFO) Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities.
8. Affected classes shall implement/migrate to Modular Distance Learning (MDL). Subject teachers may provide printed or digitized copies of lessons and activities to their learners. Monitoring of learners' outputs must be strictly observed.
9. Transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the available school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), and/or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures and regulations.
