# STATUS REPORT AND REITERATION ON THE UTILIZATION OF DYNAMIC LEARNING PROGRAM (DLP)- LEARNING ACTIVITY SHEETS (LAS) DURING CALAMITIES AND IN ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODALITIES

#### To Schools Division Superintendents

- In support of learning continuity during class disruptions caused by typhoons, disasters, calamities, and other emergencies, this Office reiterates the proper utilization of the Dynamic Learning Program (DLP) - Learning Activity Sheets (LAS) as flexible learning resources for both synchronous and asynchronous modalities.
- 2. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and schools are enjoined to maximize the use of DLP-LAS during calamities or class suspensions to sustain learner engagement. They shall ensure the timely distribution of printed or digital copies, implement monitoring and feedback mechanisms, and align utilization with existing Alternative Delivery Modalities (ADM) to ensure learning continuity and minimize disruptions.
- 3. To ensure effective monitoring, all SDOs are directed to submit a status report on the distribution and utilization of DLP-LAS.
