**2025 DIVISION SYMPOSIUM ON AWARENESS FOR PAGMAMAHAL SA  
KALIKASAN**

1. Pursuant to **Presidential Proclamation No. 479**, declaring the month of November as Filipino Values Month, and in line with Regional Memorandum No. 821, s. 2025, with the theme “Bagong Pilipinas, Bagong Pag-asa: Pagkakaisa at Pananagutan para sa Makabuluhang Pagbabago,” this Division shall conduct a Symposium on Awareness for *Pagmamahal sa Kalikasan* on **November 25, 2025 at 3:00 PM via Google Meet**.
2. This activity is anchored on the Department of Education’s Core Values—Maka-Diyos, Maka-tao, Makakalikasan, and Makabansa, and is aligned with: DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2019 – *Elaborated Curricula on the Core Values*, Republic Act No. 11480 / 11479 – *Integration of GMRC and Values Education*, DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024 – *MATATAG Curriculum* emphasizing character development and ecological stewardship, DepEd Order No. 44, s. 2022 – *Brigada Pagbasa and environmental advocacy support*, DepEd’s Environmental Education Mandate guided by RA 9512: *Environmental Awareness and Education Act*.
3. The symposium aims to strengthen learners’ and teachers’ appreciation of Pagmamahal sa Kalikasan as a core Filipino value and DepEd core value; raise awareness on environmental stewardship, conservation practices, and responsible citizenship; encourage school-based initiatives promoting eco-friendly behaviors, sustainable practices, and values-driven environmental advocacy; and integrate environmental values into GMRC, Values Education, and related learning areas.
4. The activity shall be conducted online via Google Meet. The link will be shared with all school heads, guidance coordinators, and teachers at least two days prior to the event.
5. Expected participants include: School Heads, School Guidance Counselors/Coordinators, Values Education and GMRC Teachers, Youth Formation Coordinators, Supreme Student Government (SSG/SPG) representatives, and interested teaching and non-teaching personnel.

6. Schools are encouraged to utilize insights from the symposium for: Classroom discussions, School-based environmental campaigns, Values formation activities, ASAL sa ARAL Program integration, and SIP/AIP environment-related initiatives.

7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned stakeholders is imperative to ensure compliance and awareness of the reiterated policies.
